

GENERAL DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Neal Stinson
 _____, residing at College St

 State of Alabama, do hereby nominate, constitute
 and appoint Sarah S. Crabtree, residing at Goodlettsville, County
 of Davidson, State of Tennessee, my true and lawful attorney-in-fact,
 for me and in my name, place, and stead, and for my use and benefit:

To ask, demand, sue for, recover, collect, and receive all
 sums of money, debts, dues, accounts legacies, bequests, interest,
 dividends, annuities, and demands whatsoever as are now or shall
 hereafter become due, owing, payable, or belonging to me and have
 use, and take all lawful ways and means in my name or other wise for
 the recovery thereof, by attachments, arrests, distress, or otherwise
 and to compromise and agree to the same and give acquitances or
 other sufficient discharges for the same;

For me and in my name, to make, seal, and deliver, bargain
 contract, agree for, purchase, receive, and take lands, tenements, and
 hereditaments, and accepts the possession of all lands, and all
 deeds and other assurance, in the law therefor, and to lease,
 let, demise, bargain, sell, remise, release, convey, mortgage, and
 hypothecate lands, tenements, and hereditaments upon such terms
 and conditions and under such covenants as he shall think fit;

Also to bargain and agree to buy, sell, mortgage, hypoth-
 ecate, and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods,
 wares, and merchandise, choses in action, and other property in
 possession or in action, and to make, do, and transact all and
 every kind of business of whatsoever nature and kind;

And also for me and in my name, and as my act and deed,
 to sign, seal execute, deliver, and acknowledge such deeds, leases,
 mortgages, hypothecations, bills of lading, bills, bonds, notes,
 receipts, evidence of debt, releases and satisfaction of mortgage,
 judgments and other debts, and such other instruments in writing
 of whatsoever kind and nature as may be necessary or proper in
 the premises;

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney-in-fact full
 power and authority to do and perform every act necessary, requisite,
 or proper to be done in and about the premises as fully as I might
 or could do if personally present, with full power of substitution and
 revocation, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney
 shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof.

This power of attorney shall not be affected by disability,
 incompetency, or incapacity of the principal.
