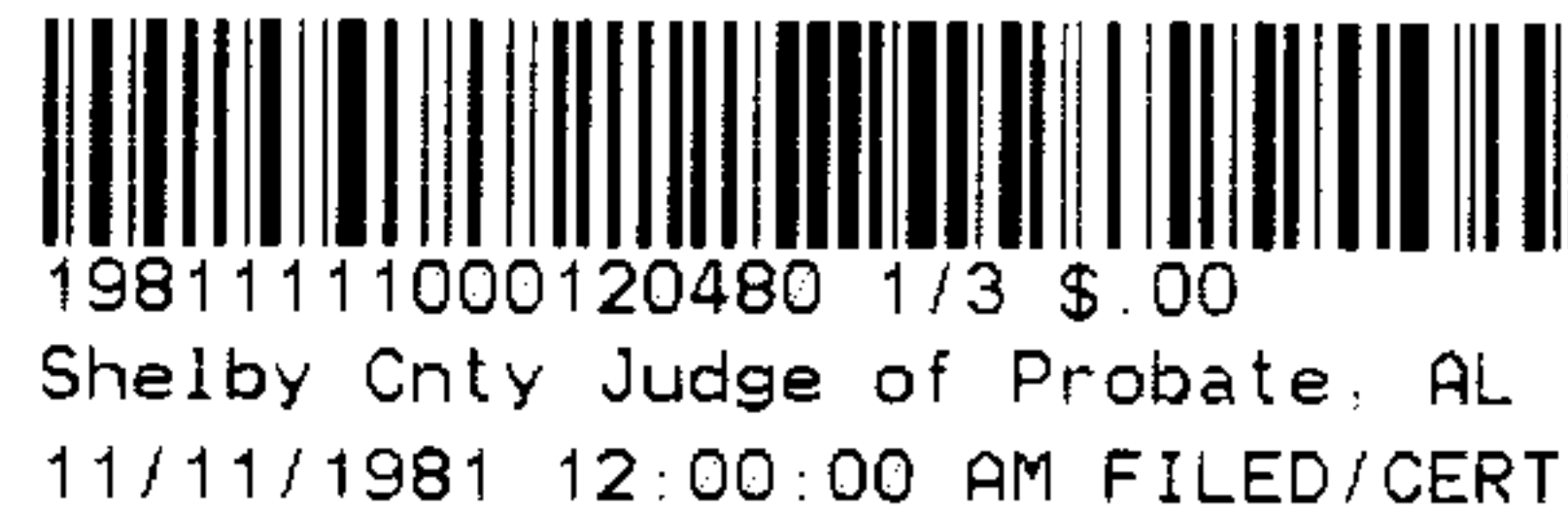

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that whereas, Larry Gene Turner, hereinafter referred to as Plaintiff, and Mitzi Hamner Turner, hereinafter referred to as Defendant, are in the process of obtaining a divorce in the Circuit Court of Shelby County, Alabama and are desirous of settling and defining their relative obligations to each other and to the issue of this marriage, in the event a decree of divorce is granted, do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The furniture and furnishings owned by the parties shall be equitably divided to include but not limited to the following:

(A) The Plaintiff shall be awarded the House trailer and land for which he will be responsible for all future payments, washer, dryer, air conditioner, rocking chair, stereo and speakers, color TV, table and chairs, half of towels and linens, all archery supplies, oak chest of drawers, towel rack in bath room, curtains, refrigerator, dish washer, and guns.

(B) The Defendant shall be awarded all lamps, wardrobe, living room set, 3 chairs, 1 love seat, B&W TV, hair dryer, toaster, iron bed and mattress, night table, canister set, rug, blender, mixer, can opener, all pictures and bric-a-brac, bath room rug set, pots and pans, all plants, all silverware, trunk, coffee table, Jennings Compound and Arrows, electric fry pan, large mirror, sewing machine table, sewing machine, bar-b-que grill, chest of drawers.

2. The Plaintiff shall be responsible for the debt owed to Master Charge and Sears.

3. The Defendant waives any alimony for herself.
