It is agreed and understood that this lease covers only oil, gas, gas derivatives, and other gaseous and liquid hydrocarbons, and sulphur; It does not cover coal, iron ore, or any other minerals.

Lessee shall be responsible for all damages caused by lessee's operations under this lease.

Whereas the "Royalties" in paragraph 3 hereinbelow to be paid lessors reads one-eighth, the same is hereby amended to one-sixth.

It is the intention of Lessor and Lesser that this lease shall also include, and there is hereby included, granted, leased and let, for the purposes and consideration herein stated, all the land owned or claimed by Lessor, adjacent or contiguous to the land particularly described above, whether the same be in said section or sections, grant or grants, or in adjacent sections or grants, although not included with the houndaries

of the land particularly described above. For the purpose of determining the amount of any money payment hereunder, the lands herein shall be treated as comprising 40,00 across whether there be more or less, and in the event of a partial assignment of surrender, the assignment or surrender.

2 Subject to the other provisions herein contained, this lease shall be for a term of toxy ears from this base (called "primary term") and as long thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land.

3. The royalites to be paid by Lessee are: (a) on oil, one-eighth (1/8) of that produced and saved from said land, the same to be delivered at the wells or to the credit of Lesser into the pipeline to which the wells may be connected; Lessee may from time to time porchase any royalty oil in its possession, paying the market price therefor prevailing for the field where produced on the date of purchase, in either case such interest to hear its proportion of any expense of treating immerchantable oil to render it merchantable as crude; (b) on gas, one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the well of the gas used by Lessee in operations not connected with the land leased or any powled unit containing all or a part of said land; the royalty on gas sold by Lessee to be one-eighth (1/8) of the amount realized at the well from such sales; (c) one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the mouth of the well of gas used by Lessee in manufacturing gaseline or other by-products, except that in computing such value, there shall be excluded all gas or components thereof used in lease or unit operations; and (d) on all other minerals mined and marketed, one-tenth (1/10) either in kind or value at the well or mine, at Lessee's election, except that on sulpluin mined and marketed, the tovalty shall be lifty cents (50c) per long ton. 4. Lessee, at its option, is bereby given the right and power to prod or combine the acreage covered by this bease or any portion thereof with other land, lease or leases in the immediate vicinity thereof, when in Lessee's judgment it is necessary or advisable to do so in order properly', develop and operate said premises in compliance with any lawful spacing rules which may be prescribed for the field in which this lease is situated by any duly authorized authority, or when to do so would, in the judgment of Lessee, promote the conservation of the oil and gas in and under and that may be produced from said premises. Lessee shall execute in writing an instrument identifying and describing the production acreage so product into a tract or unit shall be treated, for all purposes except the payment of royalties on production from the product mat as if it were included in this lease. If production is found on the product acreage, it shall be treated as if production is had from this lease, whether the well or wells be located on the premises except in the slave or not. The payment or tender of rental may be made by the cleek or draft of Lesser mailed or delivered to Lessor or to said bank on or before such date of payment. If such bank (or any successor bank) should fail, liquidate or be succeeded by another bank, or for any reason fail or refuse to accept rental. Lesser shall not be held in default for failure to make such payment or tender of rental until thirty (30) days after Lessor shall deliver to Lesser a proper revordable instrument, naming another bank as agent to receive such payments or tenders. The down cash payment is consideration for this lease according to its terms and shall not be allocated as mere rental for a period. Lesser may at any time or times execute and deliver to Lessor or to the depository above named or place of revord a release covering any portion or portions of the above described premises and therefore its reduced by surface or release as to such portion or portions and be relieved of all obligations as to the acreage surrendered, and thereafter the rentals payable beremider shall be reduced in the proportion that the acreage covered bertely is reduced by said release or release.

If prior to discovery of oil, gas or other mineral on said land or on acreage pooled therewith Lessee should drill a dry hole or holes thereon, or if after discovery of oil, gas or other mineral, the production thereof should cease from any cause, this lease shall not terminate if Lessee commences additional drilling or reworking operations within 60 days thereafter or if it be within the primary term, commences or resonance the payment or tender of rentals or commences operations for drilling or reworking on or before the rental paying date next ensuing after the expiration of 60 days from date of completion of dry hole or essation of production. If at any time subsequent to sixty (60) days prior to the beginning of the last year of the primary term and prior to the discovery of oil, gas or oiler mineral on said land, or on acreage product therewith. Lessee should drill a dry hole thereon, no rental payment or operations are necessary in order to keep the lease in lorce during the remainder of the primary term. If at the expiration of the primary term, if after discovery of oil, gas or other mineral is not being produced on said land, or on acreage product therewith, but Lessee is then engaged in drilling or reworking operations thereon or shall have emploted a dry hole thereon within sixty (60) days prior to the end of the primary term, the lease shall remain in force so long as operations are prosecuted with no cessation of more than sixty (60) consecutive days, and if they result in the production of oil, gas or other mineral, so long thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land or acreage product therewith. In the event a well or wells producing oil or gas in jaying product operator would drill under the same or similar circumstances.

7. Lesser shall have the right at any time during or after the expiration of this lesse to remove all property and fixtures placed by Lesser on said land, including the right to draw and remove all casing. When required by Lesser, Lesser will bury all pipe lines below ordinary plow depth, and no well shall be drilled within two hundred (200) feet of any residence or barn now on said land without Lesser's consent. Lesser shall be responsible for all damages caused by Lesser's operations beremuder other than damages necessarily caused by the exercise of the rights berein granted.

8. The rights of either party bereinder may be assigned in whole or in part, and the provisions hereof shall extend to their heirs, successors and assigns; but no change or division in ownership of the land, rentals or revalties, however accomplished, shall operate to enlarge the obligations or diminish the rights of Lessee; and no change or division in such ownership shall be binding on Lessee until thirty (30) days after Lessee shall have been durnished by registered U.S. mad at Lessee's principal place of business with a certified copy of recorded instrument or instruments evidencing same. In the event of assignment hereof in whole or in part liability for breach of any obligation hereunder shall rest evelusively upon the owner of this lease or of a portion thereof who commits such breach. In the event of the death of any person entitled to rentals become recorder. Lessee may pay or tender such rentals to the certified only person entitled and have been paid. If at any time two or more persons be entitled to participant in the rental payable beremader, Lessee may pay or tender said rental pointly to such persons or to their joint credit in the depository named berein, or, at Lessee's election, the proportionate part of said rental to which each participant is entitled may be paid or tendered to him separated portion of said depository, and payable hereunder shall be apportionable as between the several leasehold owners ratably according to the surface area of each, and default in rental payment by one shall not affect the rights of other leasehold owners.
