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It is understood and agreed that this lease covers only oil, gas, gaseous derivatives and other gaseous and liquid hydrocarbons and sulphur, but does not cover coal, iron ore or any other hard minerals.

t is the intention of Lassor and Lassor that this lease shall also include, and there is hereby included, granted, leased and let, for the purposes and consideration herein stated, all the land owned or claimed by Lassor, adjacent or contiguous to the land particularly described above, whether the same be in said section or sections, grant or grants, or in adjacent sections or grants, although not included with the boundaries 200

of the land particularly described above. For the purpose of determining the amount of any money payment hereunder, the lands herein shall be treated as comprising.

A lether there be more or less, and in the event of a partial assignment of surrender, the assigned or surrendered portion or portions shall be deemed to contain the number of acres stated in such assignment or surrender.

2. Subject to the other provisions herein contained, this lease shall be for a term of ten years from this date (called "primary term") and as long thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral is produced from said land.

2. Subject to the other provisions berein contained, this lease shall be for a term of ten years from this date (caned—primary term) and as long thereafter as on, gas or other numeral is produced to a lands with which said land is produced hereunder.

3. The regulates to be paid by Lessee are: (a) on oil, one-eighth (1/8) of that produced and saved from said land, the same to be delivered at the wells or to the credit of Lessor into the pipeline to which the

wells may be connected; Lessee may from time to time purchase any royalty oil in its possession, paying the market price therefor prevailing for the field where produced on the date of purchase, in cuber case (such interest to bear its proportion of any expense of treating unmerchantable oil to render it merchantable as crude; (b) on gas, one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the well of the gas used by Lessee in operations not connected with the land leased or any pooled unit containing all or a part of said land; the royalty on gas sold by Lessee to be one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the well from such sales; (c) one-eighth (1/8) of the market value at the month of the well of gas used by Lessee in manufacturing gasoline or other by-products, except that in computing such value, there shall be evalued all gas or components thereof used in lease or unit operations; and (d) on all other minerals mined and marketed, one-tenth (1/10) either in kind or value at the well or mine, at Lessee's election, except that on suphur mined and marketed, the royalty shall be fifty cents (50c) per long too. In the event that any well or the land or on property pooled therewith (or with any part thereof) is capable of producing oil or gas or gaseous substances in paying quantities but such minerals are not being produced, then Lessee's rights may be maintained, in the absence of production or drilling operations, by commencing or resuming rental payments therein sometimes referred to as shut in gas payments) as hereinafter provided in paragraph 6. Should such conditions occur or exist at the end of or after the primary term, or within sixty (60) days prior to the expiration thereof, Lessee's rights may be extended beyond and after the primary term by the commencement, resomption or continuance of such payments at the rate and in which making such payments the expiration date of the primary term and each unniversary date thereof shall have free use of oil, gas, coal, wood and water from said land, except water from Less

4. Lassee, at its option, is hereby given the right and power to pool or combine the acreage covered by this lease or any portion thereof with other land, lease or leases in the immediate vicinity thereof, when in Lassee's judgment it is necessary or advisable to do so in order properly to develop and operate said premises in compliance with any lawful spacing rules which may be prescribed for the field in which this lease is situated by any duly authorized authority, or when to do so would, in the je 'gment of Lessee, promote the conservation of the oil and gas in and under and that may be produced from said premises. Lessee shall execute in writing an instrument identifying and describing the probled acreage. The entire acreage so pooled into a tract or unit shall be treated, for all purposes except the payment of royalties on production from the pooled unit, as it it were included in this lease. If production is found on the production from a unit so production of the royalty stipulated herein as the amount of his acreage placed in the unit or his royalty interest therein on an acreage basis bears to the total acreage so pooled in the particular unit involved.

5. If operations for drilling are not commenced on said land or on acreage probed therewith as above provided on or before one year from this date the lease shall then terminate as to both parties, unless on or before such anniversary date Lesses shall pay or terefer to Lesses or to the credit of Lesses in Merchants and Plantershank at Libertallo

Alabama (which bank and its successors are Lessor's agent and shall continue as the depository for all rentals payable hereunder regardless of changes in ownership of said land or the rentals) the sum of Two Hundred and No/100

(\$200.00

), therein called rental) which shall cover the privilege of deferring commencement of drilling operations for a period of twelve (12) months. In like manner and upon like payments or tenders annually the commencement of drilling operations may be further deferred for successive periods of twelve (12) months each during the primary term. The payment or tender of rental may be made by the check or draft of Lessor mailed or delivered to Lessor or a said bank on or before such date of payment. If such bank (or any successor bank) should fail, liquidate or be successed by another bank, or for any reason fail or refuse to accept rental. Lessor shall not be held in default for failure to make such payment or tender of rental until thirty (30) days after Lessor shall deliver to Lessor a proper recordable instrument, naming another bank as agent to receive such payments or tenders. The down cash payment is consideration for this lease according to its terms and shall not be allocated as mere rental for

a period. Lassee may at any time or times execute and deliver to Lassor or to the depository above named or place of record a release or releases covering any portion or portions of the above described premises

and thereby surrender this lease as to such portion or pertions and be relieved of all obligations as to the acreage surrendered, and thereafter the rentals payable hereunder shall be reduced in the proportion that the acreage covered hereby is reduced by said release or releases.

6. If prior to discovery of oil, gas or other mineral on said land or on acreage pooled therewith Lassee should drill a dry hole or holes thereon, or if after discovery of oil, gas or other mineral, the production thereof should cease from any cause, this lease shall not terminate if Lassee commences additional drilling or reworking operations within 60 days thereafter or if it be within the primary term, commences or resumes the payment or tender of rentals or commences operations for drilling or reworking on or before the rental paying date next ensuing after the expiration of 60 days from date of completion of dry hole or cessation of production. If at any time subsequent to sixty (60) days prior to the beginning of the last year of the primary term and prior to the discovery of oil, gas or other mineral is not being produced on said land, or on acreage profed therewith. Lassee should drill a dry hole thereon, no rental payment or operations are necessary in order to keep the lease in force during the reminder of the primary term. If at the expiration of the primary term, oil, gas or other mineral is not being produced on said land, or on acreage profed therewith, but Lassee is then engaged in drilling or reworking operations thereon or shall have completed a dry hole thereon within sixty (60) days prior to the end of the primary term, the lease shall remain in force so long as operations are prosecuted with no cessation of more than sixty (60) consecutive days, and if they result me the production of oil, gas or other mineral, so long thereafter as oil, gas or other mineral and within one hundred lifty (150) feet of and draining the leased premises, or acreage pooled therewith. Lassee agrees to drill such offset wells as a reason

7. Lassee shall have the right at any time during or after the expiration of this lease to remove all property and fixtures placed by Lassee on said laid, including the right to draw and remove all casing. When required by Lassee will bury all pipe lines below ordinary plow depth, and no well shall be drilled within two hundred (200) feet of any residence or burn now on said land without Lasser's consent. The rights of either party becomed may be assigned in whole or in part, and the provisions hereof shall extend to their heirs, successors and assigns; but no change or division in ownership of or land, rentals or royalties, however accomplished, shall operate to enlarge the obligations or diminish the rights of Lessee; and no change or division in such ownership shall be binding on Lessee until thirty (30) days after Lessee shall have been furnished by registered U. S. mail at Lessee's principal place of business with a certified copy of recorded instrument or instrument or instruments or instrument or or administrator of the estate, or if there he more, then until Lessee is furnished with evidence satisfactory to it as to the heirs or devices of the deceased, and that all debts of the estate have been paid. If at any time two or more persons be entitled to participate in the rental payable hereunder, Lessee may pay or tender said rental jointly to such persons or to their joint credit in the depository named herein; or, at Lessee's election, the proportionale part of said rental to which each participant is entitled may be paid or tendered to him separately or to his separate credit in said depository; and payment or tender to any participant of his lease as to a segregated portion of said land, the rentals payable hereunder. 9. The breach by Lessee of any obligation hereunder shall not work a forfeiture or termination of this lease nor be cause for cancellation bereof in whole or in part save as herein expressly provided. If the obligation should require the drilling of a well or wells, Lessee shall have ninety (90) days after the receipt of written notices by Lessee from Lesser specifically stating the breach alleged by Lesser within which to begin operations for the drilling of any such well or wells; and the only penalty for failure so to do shall be the termination of this lease save as to forty (40) acres for each well being worked on or producing oil or gas, to be selected by Lessee so that each forty (40) acre tract will embrace one such well. After the discovery of oil, gas or other mineral in paying quantities on said premises, Lessee shall reasonably develop the acreage retained bereinder, but in discharging this obligation it shall in no event be required to drill more than one well per forty (40) acres of the area retained bereinder and capable or producing oil, gas or other mineral in paying quantities 10. Lessor bereby warrants and agrees to defend the title to said land and agrees that Lessee at its option may discharge any tax, mortgage or other hen upon said land, either in whole or in part, and in event Lessee does so, it shall be subrogated to such lien with right to enforce same and apply rentals and royalties accroing bereinder toward satisfying same. Without impairment of Lessee's rights under the warranty in event of failure of title, it is agreed that if Lessor owns an interest in said land less than the entire fee simple estate, then the royalties and rentals to be paid Lessor shall be reduced proportionately. Failure of Lessee to reduce rental paid hereunder shall not impair the right of Lessee to reduce royalties. All royalty interest covered by this lease (whether or not owned by lessor) shall be paid out of the royalty herein provided. 11 Should Lessee be prevented from complying with any express or implied covenant of this lease, from conducting drilling or reworking operations thereon or from producing oil or gas therefrom by reason of scarcity of or inability to obtain or to use equipment or material, or by operation of force majeure, or any Federal or state law or any order, rule or regulation of governmental authority, then while so prevented, Lessee's obligation to comply with such covenant shall be suspended, and Lessee shall not be liable in damages for failure to comply therewith; and this lease shall be extended while and so long as Lessee is prevented by any such cause from conducting drilling or reworking operations on or from producing oil or gas from the leased premises; and the time while Lessee is so prevented shalf not be counted against Lessee, anything in this lease to the contrary notwithstanding. 12. The undersigned Lessor, for himself and his heirs, successors and assigns, hereby surrenders and releases all rights of homestead in the premises herein described, in so far as said rights of homestead may in any way affect the purpose for which this lease is made as recited herein, and agrees that the annual drilling deferment rental payments made to Lessor as betein provided will fully protect this lease as to the full interests of the undersigned. 13. In the event that Lessor, during the primary term of this lease, receives a bona fide offer which Lessor is willing to accept from any party offering to purchase from Lessor a lease covering any or all of the substances covered by this lease and covering all or a portion of the land described herein, with the lease becoming effective upon expiration of this lease. Lessor hereby agrees to notify Lesser in writing of said offer immediately, including in the natice the name and address of the offerer, the price offered and all other pertinent terms and conditions of the offer. Lessee, for a period of lifteen days after recent of the notice, shall have the prior and preferred right and option to purchase the lease or part thereof or interest therein, covered by the offer at the price and according to the terms and conditions specified in the offer. All offers made up to and including the last day of the primary term of this leave shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this Section. Should Lessee elect to purchase the lease pursuant to the terms berevi. it shall so notify Lessor in writing by mail or telegram prior to expiration of said 15-day period. Lessee shall promptly thereafter furnish to Lessor the new lease for execution on behalf of Lessor(s) along with Lessee's sight draft payable to Lessor in payment of the specified amount as consideration for the new lease, such draft being subject only to approval of title according to the terms thereof. Upon receipt thereof. Lessors) shall promptly execute said lease and return same along with the endorsed draft to Lessee's representative or through Lessor(s) bank of record for payment.
