WHEREAS, it has been found advantageous and to the best interest of Grantors and Grantee that an easement for such water and sewer mains be conveyed to the City of Pelham, Alabama.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One dollar (1.00) and the mutual benefits accruing to the Grantors and to the City of Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama, the Grantors have this day bargained and conveyed and by these presents do hereby grant and convey unto the City of Pelham, Shelby County, Alabama, the following right, privilege and easement, in, to, along, over, through, under and across the hereinafter described lands:

> The right and privilege to construct, erect, install, operate and maintain sewage and water mains, on, upon, along, over, through, under and across the hereinafter described lands;

The right, privilege and easement to cut, trim and remove any brush, trees, or other obstructions upon the hereinafter described lands, together with the right of ingress and egress to and from, over and above the hereinafter described lands, for the purpose of the installation and upkeep of the sewage and water system.
