ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

1. The Defendant, John Wade Watts, is found to be in wilfull
contempt of the Order of this Court contained in the Final Judgment
of Divorce rendered on January 13, 1966, and is indebted to the
Plaintiff in the sum of Five Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Five and
No/100 Dollars (\$5,625.00) representing child support arrearage.

2. The Defendant can purge himself of said contempt by

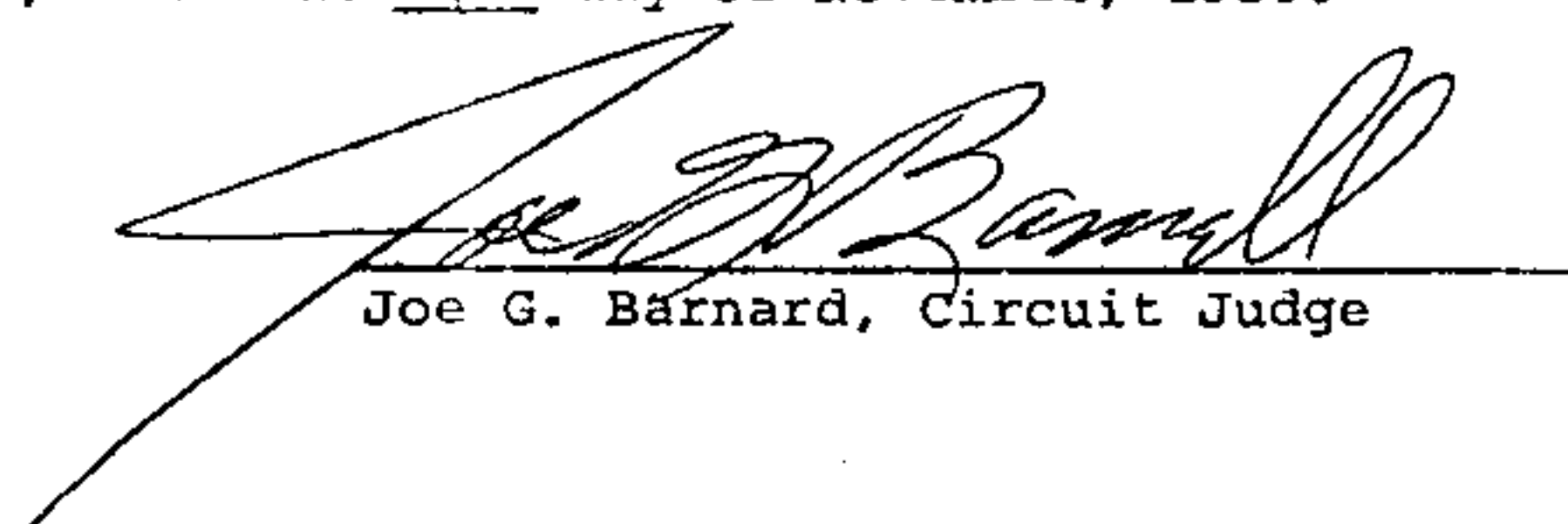
(a) By paying to the Plaintiff the sum of Five Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$500.00) on or before December 27, 1980, and;

(b) By paying to the Plaintiff the sum of Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) per month, the first of said payments being due on or before the 15th day of November, 1980, and a similar sum on or before the 15th day of each month hereafter until the minor child of the parties attains the age of Twenty One (21) years, and One Hundred Twenty Five and No/100 Dollars (\$125.00) per month thereafter until such sum is paid in full.

3. The Court retains jurisdiction of this cause to make a determination as to whether the Defendant is complying with the terms of this Order.

4. All costs incidental to these proceedings are hereby taxed against the Defendant for which let execution issue.
