James T. Wang, President, alleges that the corporation has no property, real or personal, and no assets of any kind.




VI.



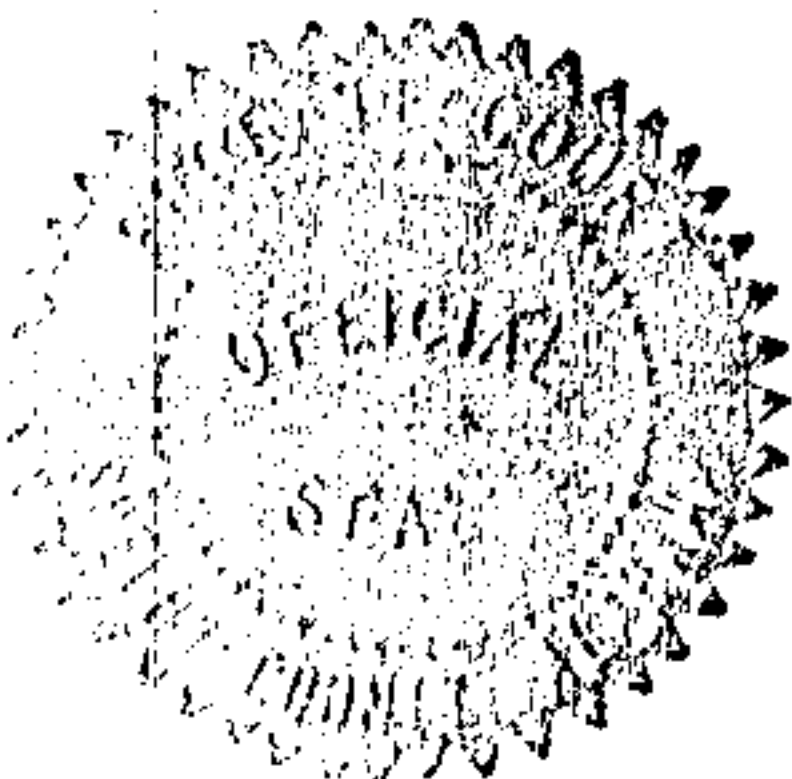
