FIFTH: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my said wife, Maude D. Collier, as my Executrix, herein giving her complete and plenary powers to distribute, sell, mortgage, subdivide and do any and every thing necessary for the distribution of my estate. In the event she should predecease me or be unable or unwilling so to serve, then in that event I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my mother-in-law, Mary F. NeSmith, as such Executrix with the same powers and duties as stated above; and in the event she should be unable or unwilling to serve as such Executrix, then in that event I appoint my sister, Mary Collier McIntosh, as such Executrix with the same powers and duties. It is my will that none of the above named be required to make any bond or any report to any Court as to her acts and doings as my Executrix. In the event of any sale of any property, such sale or sales may be made at public or private sale without the necessity of any permission or Court order. However, no distribution of any property except for necessity will be made to any of my children until they are of the age of twenty-five (25) years.

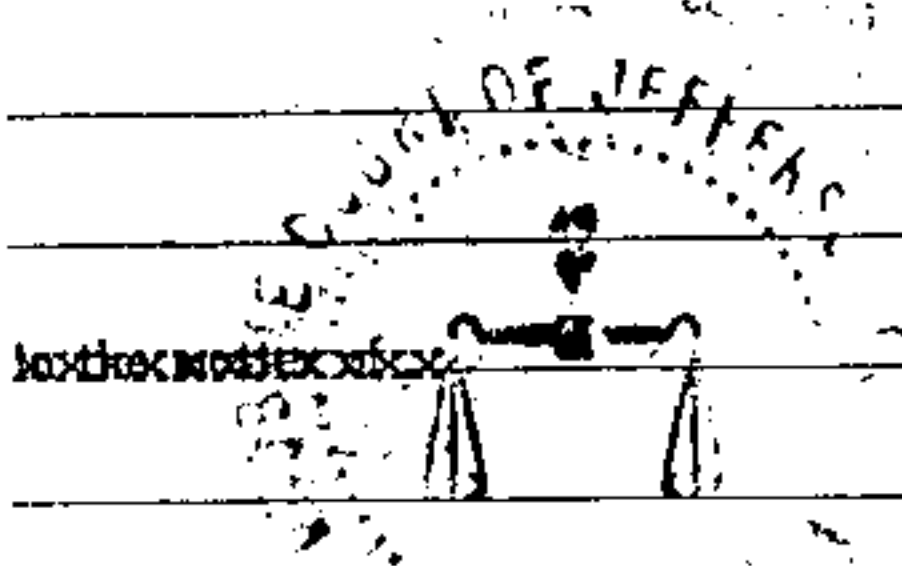
