

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporators, in order to form a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

1. NAME: The name of the corporation is:

2. PERIOD OF DURATION: The period for the duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

3. PURPOSES: The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.

4. AUTHORIZED SHARES: The aggregate number of shares of stock which the corporation shall have the authority to issue shall be 1000 shares of common stock of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share.
