PARAGRAPH I

The names of all parties to an action filed this same date in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama, seeking to condemn a right-of-way over the property hereinafter described are: Rose Wilson Upson, applicant, and Hazel Rollan Duncan.

PARAGRAPH II

The right-of-way sought to be condemned is over the following described real property, to-wit:

A part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 21, Range 1 West and described more particularly as follows: Beginning at a point 660 feet east of the northwest corner of said forty acres and run thence east along the north line of said forty 400.0 feet; thence south and parallel with the west line of said forty 400.0 feet; thence west and parallel with the north line of said forty 400.0 feet; thence north and parallel with the west line of said forty 400.0 feet to the point of beginning. There is EXCEPTED herefrom the parcel of land heretofore sold to Harry Roland.

As aforesaid, the applicant, Rose Wilson Upson, seeks to condemn a right-of-way over the above described property to gain access to the property of the applicant, as described in the Foreclosure Deed, dated July 17, 1981, as recorded in Book 334, page 112 of the Probate Court records of Shelby County, Alabama.
