

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ARCHER MARKETING, INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the ALABAMA BUSINESS CORPORATION ACT, adopt the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is:

ARCHER MARKETING, INC.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual unless and until a dissolution of said corporation shall be properly executed and filed in accordance with Alabama Law.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) To establish purchase, own, maintain and operate a storage warehouse or warehouses for the storage and deposit of goods, wares and merchandise of all kinds, nature and description for profit; and to purchase, own, lease, maintain and operate vehicles and vessels of any type for the transportation for itself or for hire, any goods, wares, merchandise, coal, ore, minerals or other substances.

(b) To act as broker, principal, agent, factor, commission merchant or otherwise, at wholesale or retail, on commission or otherwise for the foregoing products.

(c) To make, issue, purchase, acquire, hold, sell, exchange, pledge, hypothecate, or otherwise dispose of or deal in notes, acceptances, open accounts, mortgages, or evidences of indebtedness, and the obligations of any person, firm or corporation.

(d) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of any kind for any lawful purpose without limit as to amount.

(e) To have any and all powers which under the laws of the State of Alabama a corporation may have as if it were a natural person and without limitation by reason of the above enumerated powers.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is:

ONE THOUSAND SHARES OF COMMON STOCK
PAR VALUE - ONE DOLLAR PER SHARE

FIFTH: Provisions granting preemptive rights are: NONE

SIXTH: Provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of corporation are: BYLAWS OF ARCHER MARKETING, INC. which shall be adopted and included in the minutes of the corporation's books within forty-five days of the date of incorporation.
