

ANTENUPTIAL AGREEMENT

This agreement is made on the 21 day of April 1982 by and between Franz J. Wenzel, (hereafter "Wenzel") a citizen of the Federal Republic of Germany, currently residing in Shelby County Alabama, and Laurel Anne McCorstin, (hereafter "McCorstin") a citizen of the United States of America and a resident of Shelby County Alabama, in consideration of the contemplated marriage of the parties hereto.

I

Each party has completely revealed to the other the value of all property owned by that party, including future interests and expectancies of inheritance. Each party has consulted an attorney and is satisfied as to the adequacy of this disclosure.

II

Wenzel has no children on the date of this agreement, McCorstin has one child, a girl named Erin Argo, born in 1976. Neither party has any deceased children.

III

Neither party shall be liable for the debts of the other, whether contracted before or after marriage.

IV

All property owned by the parties at the time of their marriage, or acquired thereafter from any source including inheritance or earnings shall be their separate respective property and not community property.

V

Each party agrees to promptly execute any releases, waivers, or other legal papers required to enable the other party to dispose of his or her property as he or she sees fit, or otherwise to effect the terms of this agreement.

However, neither party shall be obligated to incur any liability created by the other.

VI

Wenzel agrees to provide a residence in which both parties may reside during their marriage, and to support McCorstin and any children of their marriage.

VII

In the event of a divorce, or the death of one of the parties, this agreement shall become null and void, except for part III.

VIII


The parties retain the right to make gifts to each other, whether by will or otherwise.

This agreement is integral, supersedes all previous agreements between the parties, and is binding on the parties and all their successors in interest.

This agreement shall take effect on the date that the marriage contemplated by the parties has been solemnized.
