

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES
OF INCORPORATION OF KENMAC, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 4 of the Alabama Business Corporation Act (Sections 10-2A-110 through 10-2A-122 of the Code of Alabama, 1975), the undersigned corporation executes and adopts these Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation (Certificate of Incorporation):

1. The name of the corporation is Kenmac, Inc.

2. The following amendment of the Articles of Incorporation (Certificate of Incorporation) was adopted by the shareholders of the corporation on the 11th day of August, 1982, in the manner prescribed by the Alabama Business Corporation Act:

The Articles of Incorporation (Certificate of Incorporation) of Kenmac, Inc., are hereby amended so that the First Paragraph of the said Articles of Incorporation (Certificate of Incorporation) shall read as follows:

FIRST: The name of the corporation shall be Southern Broadcast Services, Inc.

3. The number of shares of the corporation outstanding at the time of such adoption was 1,928; and the number of shares entitled to vote thereon was 1,928.

4. The number of shares voted for such amendment was 1,928; and the number of shares voted against such amendment was 0.

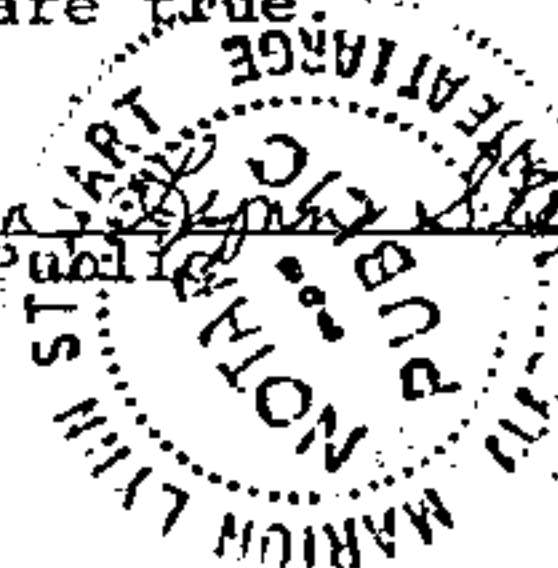
