POWER OF ATTORNEY

BOOK (a) To sell, mortgage, encumber, convey, rent, lease, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, by deed with or without warranty, bill of sale, contract or otherwise, any property, real or personal, which I may own or in which I may have an interest, or which I may hereafter acquire, located in the State of Alabama, for cash or upon such terms as said attorney in fact may deem advisable, and to execute appropriate deeds, conveyances or other instruments including contracts for that purpose and more specifically in reference to property located at Rt. 2, Box 756, Calera, Alabama 35040.

(b) To sign, endorse, receive, deposit or issue checks, bonds, notes, stocks or other obligations or instruments, and to borrow money and secure the same in any manner.

(c) To collect, sue for, settle, adjust or compromise any claim for money arising by contract or tort, to execute releases, cancellations or satisfactions, and

(d) To do any other thing or perform any other act, not limited to the foregoing, which I might do in person, it being intended that this shall be a general power of attorney.

This power of attorney shall remain effective until the same is revoked by written instrument recorded in the Office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Shelby County, Alabama.
