

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TURNER PAINTING, INC.

We, the undersigned, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Alabama, do hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation, as follows:

ARTICLE ONE: The name of the corporation is TURNER PAINTING, INC.

ARTICLE TWO: The objects for which the corporation is formed are:

- a. To engage in the business of contracting commercial painting and sandblasting.
- b. To transact any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the laws of the State of Alabama.

ARTICLE THREE: The location and mailing address of the initial registered office shall be Highway 280 E., Westover, Alabama 35185, and the name of its initial

registered agent at such address is Sidney W. Turner.

ARTICLE FOUR: The amount of total authorized capital stock shall be \$1,000.00 divided into 1,000 shares of the par value of \$1.00 per share, all to be common stock of the same class, and none preferred. The corporation will begin business with 1,000 shares of the said authorized stock fully paid for by the stockholders of the corporation.

ARTICLE SIX: There shall be no limit for the duration of the corporation, it being intended that the corporation have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE SEVEN: The corporation shall possess all the powers necessary to conduct the business or businesses and carry out the objects herein expressed and all those powers expressly conferred upon corporations by the statutes of the State of Alabama, together with all

other powers bestowed upon such corporations under any present or future laws of the State of Alabama, as well as additional powers implied therefrom.

ARTICLE EIGHT: The dates on which the stockholders meeting shall be held, the number of directors, and their terms of office, the title and number of officers and their terms of office, powers, and duties, shall be fixed by the bylaws of the corporation. Bylaws may be adopted or amended at regular meetings of the stockholders or any special meeting called for that purpose. The corporation shall have power to make bylaws for the regulation and government of the corporation, its officers, agents, servants, and employees, and for all other purposes not inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama.
