

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned, acting as Incorporators, in order to form a Corporation under and prusuant to the laws of the State of Alabama, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

1. Name: The name of the Corporation shall be Central Alabama Office Supply Corp.
2. Period of Duration: The period of duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual.
3. Purpose: The purpose for which this Corporation is organized is to transact the business of selling office supplies and equipment and any other lawful business for which Corporations may be Incorporated under the Alabama Business Corporation Act.
4. Authorized Shares: The aggregate number of shares of stock which the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is Five Hundred (500) shares of common stock with the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollar per share.

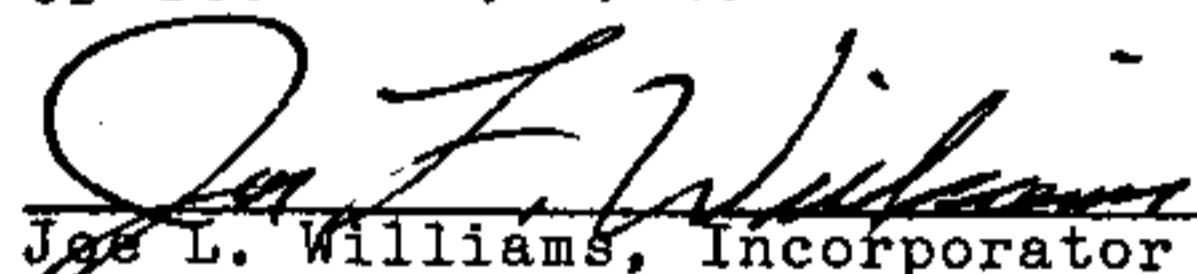
