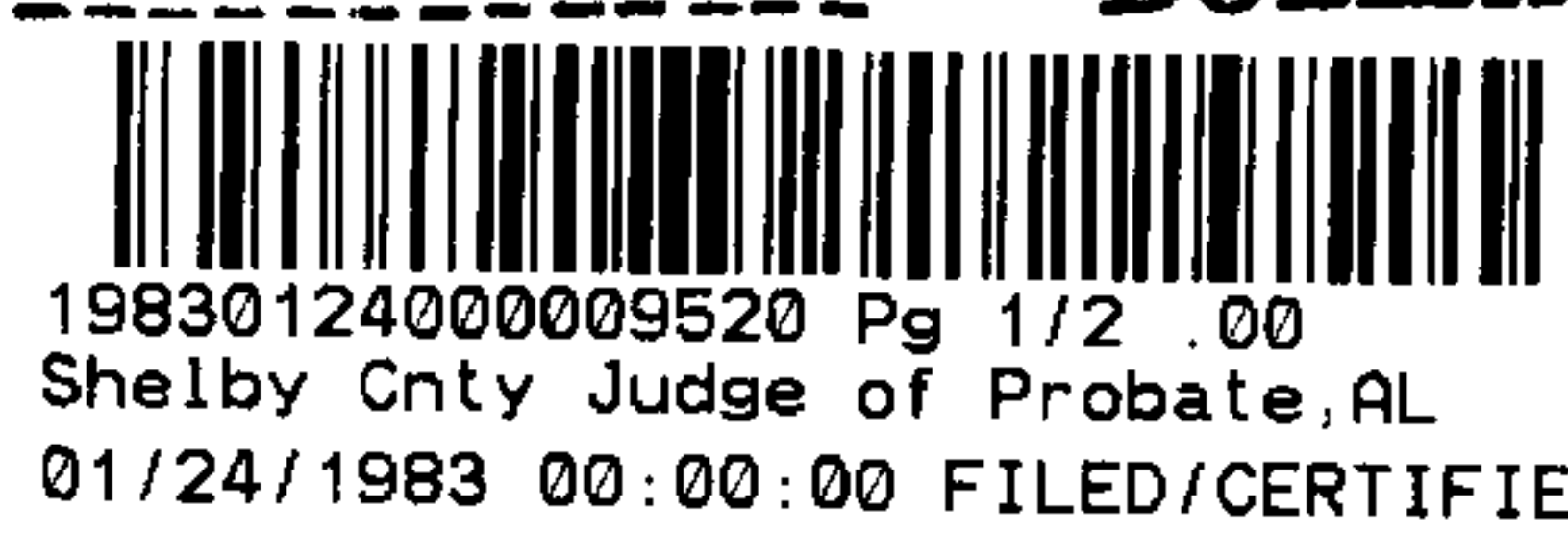

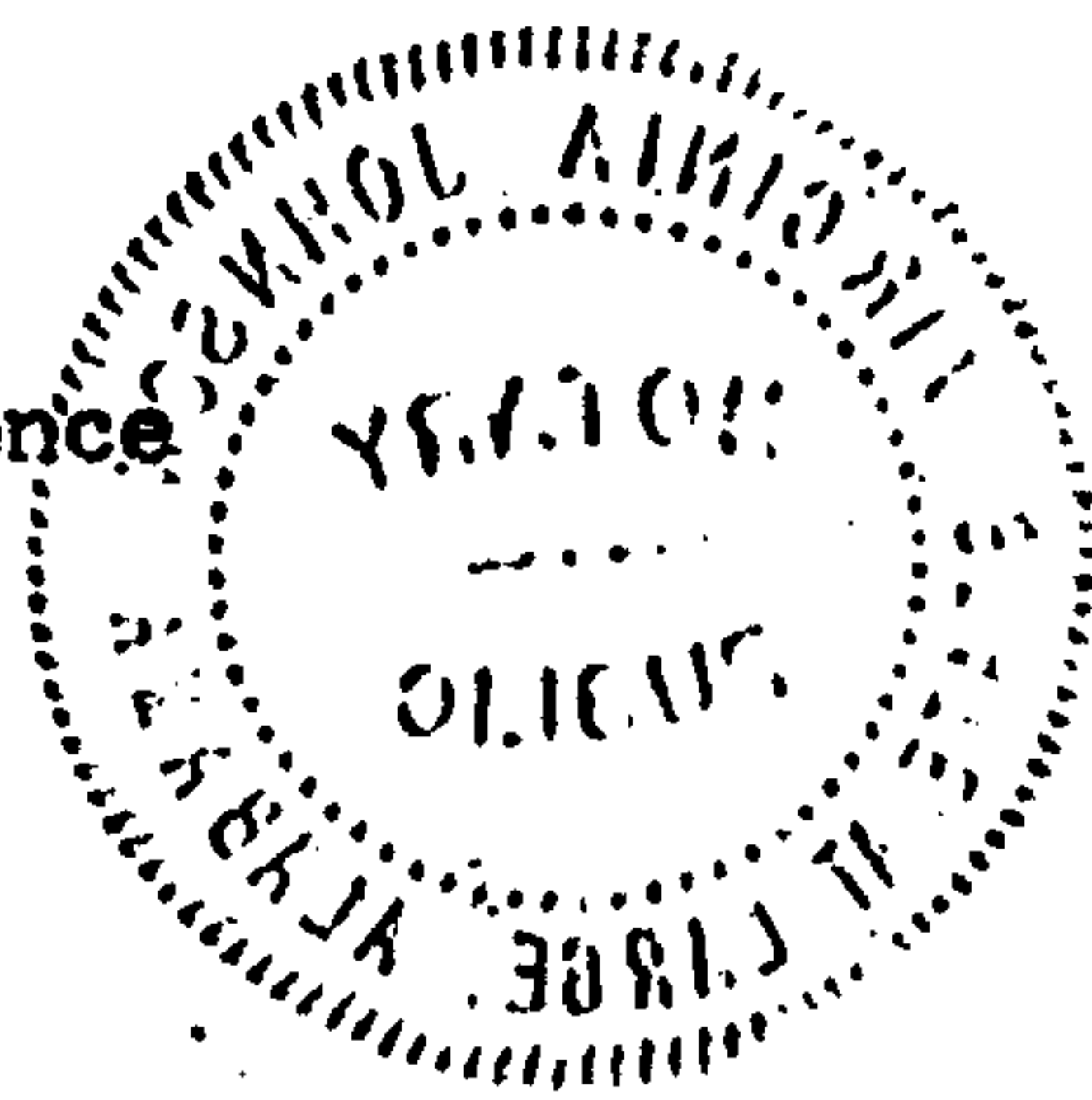

A certain lot beginning at the Elyton and Montevallo dirt road at the Southeast corner of the Walter Wooten lot, thence South 210 feet, thence West 210 feet, thence North 210 feet, thence East 210 feet, to point of beginning, containing one acre, also a certain parcel of land more particularly described as follows, commencing 540 feet South of the Northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 21, Township 21, Range 3 West, thence run South 105 feet, thence West 420 feet, thence North 315 feet, thence East 210 feet, thence South 210 feet, thence East 210 feet, to point of beginning, in all three acres, more or less.
