LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT
OF

I, Gus A. Petitt, Jr., being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, declare and constitute the following as my last will and testament, hereby expressly revoking any and all wills and/or codicils thereto heretofore made by me.

ITEM I

I do hereby will and direct that as soon as practicable after my death all of my just debts be paid.

ITEM II

If she survives me, I hereby will, bequeath and devise all of my property, real, personal, or mixed, and wherever situate, after said debts are paid, to my wife, Jane Clark Petitt, to be hers absolutely and forever.

ITEM III

In the event my wife does not survive me, then I hereby will and bequeath the following personal property to the beneficiaries named in this item:

A. All savings accounts, including certificates of deposit and all stocks or bonds to be divided four-tenths to my son, Gus Petitt, of Atlanta, Georgia, and six-tenths to my daughter, Susan P. Richardson, of Trussville, Alabama.

B. All furniture, silver, china and personal jewelry to my daughter, Susan P. Richardson.

C. Any or all automobiles which I may own at the time of my death to my son, Gus Petitt.

ITEM IV

In the event my wife does not survive me, then all the rest, residue and remainder of my property I will, bequeath and devise four-tenths to my son, Gus Petitt, and six-tenths to my daughter, Susan P. Richardson.

ITEM V

In the event my wife, Jane Clark Petitt, and I should die as the result of a common accident or under circumstances such that it could not be determined which of us died first, then I hereby will, bequeath and devise to my son, Gus Petitt, and to my daughter, Susan P. Richardson, the property set out in Item III A and B above and in the proportions therein designated. I do further bequeath and devise to my son, Gus Petitt, one of the automobiles owned by me and my wife and the other automobile to my daughter, Susan P. Richardson, with my son, Gus Petitt, having his choice of which automobile shall be his.

ITEM VI

Also in the event my wife and I die as the result of a common accident or under circumstances where it cannot be determined which of us died first, I do hereby will, bequeath, and devise the home in which my wife and I are now living, together with all furnishings therein, to my daughter, Susan P. Richardson, and my son, Gus Petitt, to be theirs absolutely and forever. Under such circumstances I do further bequeath and devise the property now owned by me and my wife on Lay Lake, together with all furnishings therein, and our boat to my son, Gus Petitt, and daughter, Susan Richardson, division being same as Item III A.

Also in such event, all of the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal or mixed, and wherever situate, I do hereby will, bequeath and devise to my two children with my son to receive four-tenths of said property and my daughter six-tenths and said property to belong to each of said beneficiaries absolutely and forever, including real property described above.

ITEM VII

(a) In the event my wife survives me, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint her as executrix of this my last will and testament and do hereby will and provide that she shall not be required to give bond, to make any inventory nor to file any report with anyone whomsoever as to my estate.
