This matter was called for trial on the regular docket for February 2, 1983.
 At that time all parties represented by counsel appeared before the Court and
 represented that they had agreed to the following final order and judgment being
 entered. Wherefore, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that:

1. Title to the following described property:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying Southeast of county road, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of
 SE $\frac{1}{4}$, E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and also all that part of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 lying Southeast of right of way of Central of Georgia Railroad,
 all in Section 33, Township 17 South, Range 1 E, Shelby County,
 Alabama.

Mineral and mining rights except on all property in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$.
 Also except a tract 81 feet by 81 feet lying in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ to
 Edgar and Clara Dillashaw and as shown by their deed recorded in
 Deed Book 209, Page 666.
 and quieted

is vested/in Archie H. Witt, III, all other parties to this suit acknowledging
 that they claim no right, title, or interests in that property. The interest
 of Archie Witt/III is free and clear of all liens and claims from any other party to
 this action, including, but not limited to, the various judgments against Shelby
 Silica Sands which had been recorded.

2. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of American Title Insurance Company
 and against Palmer G. O'Barr in the sum of FORTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$40,000.00)
 DOLLARS on the cross-claim for breach of warranty.

3. All other or further claims between the parties to this action are hereby
 dismissed with prejudice.
