 had deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Muskogee, Alabama,
 whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Samuel H. Harris

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 3rd of April, 1830, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands, for the East half of the North West quarter of section 36, of Township 36 N. Range 10 W. in the District of the Florida and State of Alabama, containing eight acres and twenty two hundredths of an acre.

According to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Samuel H. Harris

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Samuel H. Harris the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold, the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Samuel H. Harris and his heirs and assigns forever.
