THIS CONTRACT, entered into this 13th day of April, 1983,
 between UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation, hereinafter for
 convenience called "Grantor," and COLONIAL PIPELINE COMPANY, a corporation, herein-
 after for convenience called "Grantee";

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, by contract dated June 20, 1972, Grantor granted to Grantee the
 right to construct, operate, maintain, and remove a pipeline 36 inches in diameter
 upon and across certain land of Grantor including that shown on map attached hereto;
 and

WHEREAS, it is desired to amend said contract to grant Grantee the right
 to construct a solar cathodic protection unit and facilities therefor.

NOW THEREFORE:

It is hereby agreed by and between Grantor and Grantee that said contract
 dated June 20, 1972, shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

(1) Grantor, in consideration of the covenants of Grantee as hereinafter
 expressed to be kept and performed, and in further consideration of the sum of One
 Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations in hand paid to Grantor by Grantee,
 the receipt whereof is acknowledged, and to the extent of the ownership of Grantor,
 hereby grants and conveys to Grantee the right to install, maintain, use and
 remove a solar cathodic protection unit and facilities therefor, including, without
 limitation, a buried cable and deep wells, in and on certain land of Grantor in
 the South-West quarter of South-West quarter of Section 9, Township 21 South,
 Range 4 West, Shelby County, Alabama, in the location as shown on map marked
 "81-642 LD" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

(2) For said consideration, Grantor hereby further grants and conveys
 unto Grantee such rights of ingress and egress over its land as may be necessary
 for the installation, maintenance, use and removal of said facilities in and on
 said land; Grantor may at any time in the future define the routes of such ingress
 and egress, provided such routes shall provide reasonable access to said facilities.

(3) The rights herein granted shall not be construed to be superior to
 but are subject to presently existing easements for: (a) electric power trans-
 mission lines; (b) telephone and telegraph lines; (c) pipelines; (d) public roads,
 and (e) private roads.

(4) Grantee shall have the right to trim and/or cut such trees as may interfere with the installation or endanger the safety or proper maintenance of said facilities; Grantee shall, however, pay Grantor for the reasonable timber market value of all trees cut, injured or destroyed in the installation of said facilities and thereafter during maintenance of said facilities.

(5) Grantee shall have the same rights and be bound by the same obligations with reference to the rights herein granted as it has under said contract dated June 20, 1972, with reference to the construction, operation, and maintenance of the previously installed 36 inch pipeline facilities.

(6) Except as hereby amended, all the terms and conditions of said contract dated June 20, 1972, shall remain in full force and effect.

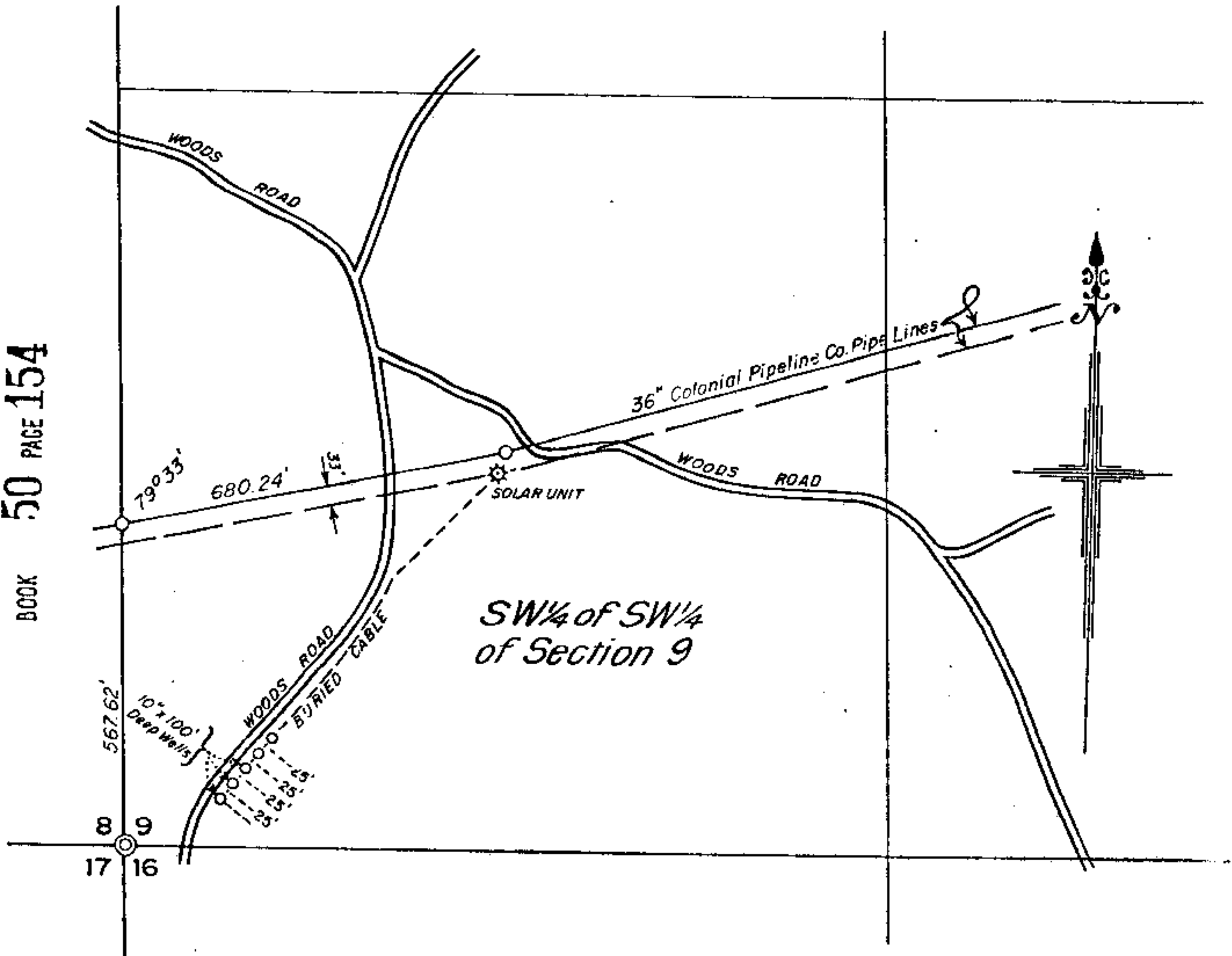
