ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR(S)' MOTION TO AVOID
JUDICIAL LIENS ON EXEMPT PROPERTY

On Motion, after notice and hearing, and on the appearance of the attorneys named below and upon the evidence produced at the hearing, the Court determines that the property herein described constitutes exempt property within the meaning of 522(f) and (h) of the Bankruptcy Code and the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama and the United States, viz:

Lots 3 and 4 in Block 255 of J. H. Dunstan's Survey of the Town of Calera, Alabama, and located in Shelby County, Alabama.
All Household goods and personalty as described in Debtors' petition on file in this Court.

And the Trustee having filed his Report of Abandonment or Report of Exempt Property, the Court declares and approves the exemptions allowed; and the Court further finds that the following creditors hold judicial liens which impair the exemptions of the debtor, which the debtor elects to avoid:

IT IS ACCORDINGLY ORDERED:

That the said judgment liens are voided and annulled and the debtor takes the above described property free and clear of any lien or claim of the named creditors.

Said creditors are free to file an unsecured claim in the above styled case within twenty (20) days.
