JONES, , an adult resident citizen of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all former wills or codicils thereto at any time heretofore made by me.

ITEM ONE: I desire and I hereby direct that all of my legal debts, including my funeral expenses and the expenses of my last illness, be paid out of my estate by my Executors, or, as the case may be, my alternate Executor, both hereinafter named, as soon after my death as may be practicable and convenient.

ITEM TWO: I hereby give, devise, and bequeath all of my real estate, including my river property, and my home to my two sons, namely; ROY D. JONES, and LOUIE J. JONES, to be theirs equally, share and share alike.

ITEM THREE: I hereby give and bequeath the sum of \$10,000.00 to each of my two grandchildren, namely: LINDA JONES ARCHER, and TOMMY R. JONES.

ITEM FOUR: I hereby give and bequeath the sum of 2,000.00 to my former daughter-in-law, LOUISE M. ANDERSON.

ITEM FIVE: I hereby give, devise and bequeath all the rest, residue, and remainder of my property, of whatsoever kind and character, real, personal or mixed, and wheresoever situated, unto my beloved children, ROY D. JONES and LOUIE J. JONES, to be theirs equally, share and share alike.

ITEM SIX: I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my children, ROY D. JONES and LOUIE J. JONES, as Joint-Executors of this my Last Will and Testament. I hereby direct that my said Joint-Executors shall not be required to give or furnish any bond, or other security in any jurisdiction, or file any inventory, or make any accounting and/or settlement in or with any court as to the
