ONE.

The names of the persons forming the within public corporation, together with the residence of each thereof, are:

Margie D. Isbell, whose place of residence is Highway 474, in Shelby County, Alabama; and

*Robert F. McCullough, whose place of residence is Lake Circle Drive, Route 1, in Shelby County, Alabama.

Each of the foregoing named persons states and certifies that each of them is of the age of nineteen or more years, that each of them is a resident of and owner of real property in the area of Shelby County, Alabama, in which the within public corporation proposes to render water service, and that each of them is a duly qualified elector of said county.

The name of this public corporation is Dunavant Valley Water Authority (hereinafter called the "Authority").

THREE.

The duration of this public corporation shall be perpetual, subject to the provisions of Section 11-88-18 of the CODE OF ALABAMA 1975.

T18S, RIW - all of Section 13; the Southeast 1/4 of Section 23; all of Section 24; the North 1/2 of Section 25; and the North 1/2 of Section 26;

all lying wholly in Shelby County, Alabama.

This corporation shall have and exercise all the power and authority set forth in the provisions of Article 1 of Chapter 88 of Title 11 of the CODE OF ALABAMA 1975, for corporations organized thereunder to operate a water system, and such additional power and authority as is now or may hereafter be provided by law.
