STATUTORY WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of Eleven Thousand and NO/100 Dollars (\$11,000.00) to the undersigned Grantor, SouthTrust Bank of Alabama, National Association, (whose name formerly was "Birmingham Trust National Bank"), (hereinafter called Grantor), in hand paid by Kenneth Bruce York and Elizabeth Weaver York (hereinafter called Grantees), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the Grantees for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to wit:

Lot 14, according to the Survey of Quail Run, Phase 3 as recorded in Map Book 7, page 159 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

Subject to:

1. Ad Valorem taxes for 1984;
2. Existing rights of ways, encroachments, party walls, building restrictions, zoning, recorded/unrecorded easements, deficiencies in quantity of ground, overlaps, overhangs, any discrepancies or conflicts in boundry lines, or any matters not of record, if any, which would be disclosed by an inspection and survey of the property;

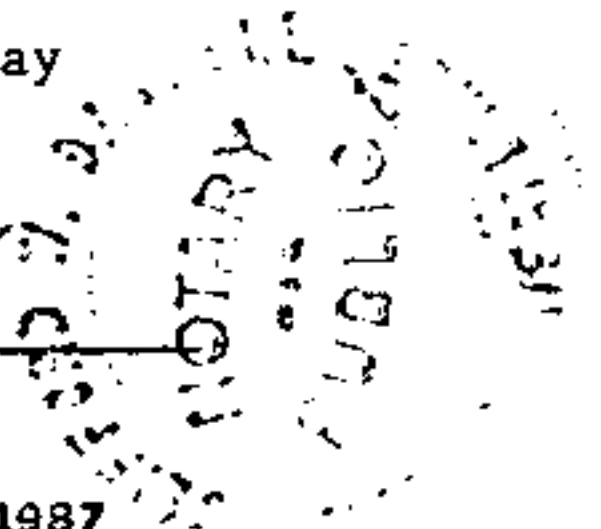
