In the event of the inability or the unwillingness of my son, William Homer Panter to serve as the Executor of this My Last Will and Testament I then nominate and appoint my daughter, Willa Mae Panter Whatley, as the Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and I further designate that she shall not be
