Ι.

The name of said proposed corporation is: HUNT MORTON, INCORPORATED

II.

That the nature of the business, or objects, or purposes proposed to be transacted, promoted, or carried on are:

- 1. To buy, acquire, invest in, hold, make improvements upon and to lease and manage real property of every kind.
 - 2. To own and operate a general manufacturing and trading business and to buy, sell, manufacture, and generally deal in merchandise, equipement, and supplies of all types and kinds, and to buy, apply for or own and dispose of patents, copyrights, and inventions, and to license others in the use thereof in the United States and in foreign countries.
 - 3. To buy, own, and sell and trade in mortgage and commercial papers, to buy, own and sell and otherwise deal in megotiable instruments of every kind, to borrow money, to lend money and discount notes and commercial paper, to otherwise deal in and finance purchase money contracts and lease sale contracts; to buy, hold and sell real estate; to acquire stock in other corporations; to acquire bonds, to purchase accounts and contracts and to finance other corporations or institutions of a like kind; to operate and own a general brokerage business.
