I hereby constitute and appoint my wife, Dolly B. Spearman, as Executrix of this, my Last Will and Testament and direct that she shall serve without bond and shall not be required to file an inventory or make any settlement thereof in any Court. Should my said wife predecease me, or shall fail or be unable to serve as such Executrix,
