Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said County and State, personally appeared Lee Byers Harris who, being known to me and being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

My name is Lee Byers Harris, and I am presently seventy-three (73) years of age. I have lived in the Alabaster community all of my life. I am very familiar with the parcel of land purchased by Willie Mae Bishop and her deceased husband, Taft Bishop, in June of 1954 from George Robinson and wife, Bessie Lee Robinson. The parcel of land purchased by Willie Mae Bishop and Taft Bishop is located across the street from my home place. My wife and I were living across the road from the Bishop property when Willie Mae Bishop and Taft Bishop purchased the property from the Robinsons. The parcel of land was vacant when the Bishops purchased it from the Robinsons. Shortly after Taft Bishop and his wife went into possession of the property as described in that certain deed recorded in Deed Book 166, Page 520 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, they built their home on the property. Willie Mae Bishop and her husband, until his death, have occupied and been in possession of the property purchased from the Robinsons since June 3, 1954. Taft Bishop died in May of 1980. Willie Mae Bishop and her deceased husband, Taft Bishop, have occupied the property actually, exclusively, openly, notoriously, hostilely, and continuously since June of 1954. I have never heard the title to the property questioned in any way. To my knowledge, no other person, firm, or corporation has claimed any interest in the property and there is no dispute with any of the surrounding property owners as to the Bishop ownership of the property.
