11. Forbearance by Lender Not a Waiver. Lender shall have waived such option to accelerate if, prior to the sale or transfer. 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19. Borrower's Right to Reinstate. Notwithstanding Lender's acceleration of the sums secured by this Mortgage, Borrower shall have the right to have any proceedings begun by Lender to enforce this Mortgage discontinued at any time prior to the earlier to occur of (i) the fifth day before sale of the Property pursuant to the power of sale contained in this Mortgage or (ii) entry of a judgment enforcing this Mortgage if: (a) Borrower pays Lender all sums which would be then due under this Mortgage, the Note and notes securing Future Advances, if any, had no acceleration occurred; (b) Borrower cures all breaches of any other covenants or agreements of Borrower contained in this Mortgage; (c) Borrower pays all reasonable expenses incurred by Lender in enforcing the covenants and agreements of Borrower contained in this Mortgage and in enforcing Lender's remedies as provided in paragraph 18 hereof, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees; and (d) Borrower takes such action as Lender may reasonably require to assure that the lien of this Mortgage, Lender's interest in the Property and Borrower's obligation to pay the sums secured by this Mortgage shall continue unimpaired. Upon such payment and cure by Borrower, this Mortgage and the obligations secured thereby shall remain in full force and effect as if no acceleration had occurred.

20. Assign—ent of Rents; Appointment of Receiver; Lender in Possession. As additional security hereunder, Borrower bereby assigns to Lender the rents of the Property, provided that Borrower shall, prior to acceleration under paragraph 18 hereof or abandonment of the Property, have the right to collect and retain such rents as they become due and payable.

Upon acceleration under paragraph 18 hereof or abandonment of the Property. Lender, in person, by agent or by judicially appointed receiver, shall be entitled to enter upon, take possession of and manage the Property and to collect the rents of the Property including those past due. THE NOTE CONTAINS PROVISIONS ALLOWING FOR CHANGES IN THE INTEREST RATE AND THE MONTHLY PAYMENT AND FOR INCREASES IN THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT TO BE REPAID.

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS. In addition to the covenants and agreements made to the Security Instrument, Borrower and Lender further covenant and agree as follows:

A. INTEREST RATE AND MONTHLY PAYMENT CHANGES

The Note Holder will then round the result of this addition to the nearest one-eighth of one percentage point (0.125%). This rounded amount will be the new rate of interest until the next Interest Change Date.

In the event the total balance due on the loan including Accrued Unpaid Interest equals 115% of the original loan balance, the payment will be adjusted to begin amortizing this balance until the next Payment Change Date or Interest Change Date,

Borrower may, at Borrower's option and provided Borrower how them current on the Ioan for twelve months prior to the applicable Change date, and the Ioan balance is fully amortizing, modify the repayment terms of the Indebtedness secured hereby prior to the first, second, third, or fourth Payment Change Date. At that time, Borrower may convert the adjustable rate Ioan evidenced by the Note into a fixed Interest rate Ioan to be fully repaid in equal monthly payments of principal and interest over the remaining term of the Ioan (1.e. 29, 28, 27, or 20 years, depending on the conversion date selected).
- 2. Lender's Mortgage Loan Adjustment Notice given prior to the first, second, third, or fourth Payment Change Date shall contain the following information pertaining to Borrower's option to convert:
 - (a) the approximate fixed interest rate payable by Borrower in Borrower converts into a fixed interest rate loan (the actual rate will be the rate in effect on the date the conversion is registered);
 - (b) the approximate amount of Borrower's new monthly payment at the fixed rate of interest; and
 - (c) a date, at least 15 days from the date the Notice is given, by which Borrower must "lock in" an interest rate by telephoning a number provided in the Notice and registering the conversion with the Lender, and a subsequent date (no later than the applicable Change Date) by which the Borrower must complete, execute and deliver to Lender a document in the form required by Lender evidencing the modification of the Note to provide a fixed interest rate.
- 3. The fixed rate of interest payable by Borrower will be indentical to Lender's market rate of price protected delivery of 30-year fixed rate, level payment, fully amortizing loans on the date the conversion is registered. The new fixed interest rate will become effective on the applicable Interest Change Date.

Borrower's monthly payments at the new fixed interest rate will begin as of the first monthly payment after the applicable Interest Change Date. The monthly payment will be the amount that is necessary to repay in full the principal Borrower will owe (assuming timely payment of all amounts due prior to the date) on the Payment Change Date in substantially equal payments by the maturity date set forth in the Note at the fixed interest rate.

- 4. Borrower must register the loan for conversion and must complete, execute and deliver to Lender the document evidencing the modification of the Note prior to the applicable dates set forth in Lender's Notice as provided above. If Borrower fails to do so within the specified time frames, Borrower can no longer exercise the option to convert and in this case, the terms of the Note will continue in effect without any change.
- B. CHARGES; LIENS
 Uniform Covenant 4 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:
 - 4. Charges; Liens. Borrower shall pay all taxes, assessments, and any other charges, fines and impositions attributable to the Property which may attain priority over this Security Instrument, and teasehold payments or ground tents, if any, in the manner provided under paragraph 2 hereof or, if not paid to such manner, by Borrower making payment, when due, directly to the payer thereof. Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender all notices of amounts due under this paragraph, and in the event Borrower shall make payment directly.

Borrower shall promptly furnish to Lender receipts evidencing such payments, Borrower shall promptly discharge any Hen which has priority over this Security Instrument; provided that Borrower shall not be required to discharge any such lien so long as Borrower: (a) shall agree in writing to the payment of the obligation secured by such Hen in a manner acceptable to Lender; (b) shall in good faith contest such Hen by, or defend against enforcement of such Hen in, legal proceedings which in the opinion of Lender operate to prevent the enforcement of the Hen or forfeiture of the Property or any part thereof; or (c) shall secure from the holder of such Hen an agreement in a form satisfactory to Lender subordinating such Hen to this Security Instrument.

If Lender determines that all or any part of the Property is subject to a lien which may attain a priority over this Security Instrument, Lender shall send Borrower notice indentifying such lien. Borrower shall satisfy such lien or take one or more of the actions set forth above within ten days of the giving of notice

C. NOTICE

Uniform Covenant 14 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:

14. Notice. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Borrower provided for in this Security Instrument shall be given by delivering it or by mailing it by first class mail addressed to Borrower at the Property Address or at such other address as Borrower may designate by notice to Lender as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Lender shall be given by first class mail to Lender's address stated herein or to such other address as Lender may designate by notice to Borrower as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this Security Instrument shall be deemed to have been given to Borrower or Lender when given in the manner designated herein.

UNIFORM MORTCACE; GOVERNING LAW; SEVERABILITY Uniform Covenant 15 is amended to read as follows:

- 15. Uniform Mortgage; Governing Law; Severability. This form of Security Instrument combines uniform covenants for national use and non-uniform covenants with Ilmited variations by jurisdiction to constitute a uniform security instrument covering real property. This Security Instrument shall be governed by federal law and the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. In the event that any provision or clause of this Security Instrument or the Note conflicts with applicable law, such conflict shall not affect other provisions of this Security Instrument or the Note which can be given effect without the conflicting provision, and to this end the provisions of this Security Instrument and the Note are declared to be severable.
- E. NO FUTURE ADVANCES
 Non-Uniform covenant 21 of the Security Instrument ("Future Advances") is deleted.
- F, LOAN CHARGES

If the loan secured by the Security Instrument is subject to a law which sets maximum loan charges, and that law is finally interpreted so that the interest or other loan charges collected or to be collected in connection with the loan exceed permitted limits, then: (1) any such loan charge shall be reduced by the amount necessary to reduce the charge to the permitted limits; and (2) and sums already collected from Borrower which exceeded permitted limits will be refunded to Borrower. Lender may choose to make this refund by reducing the principal owed under the Note or by making a direct payment to the Borrower. If a refund reduces principal, the reduction will be treated as a partial prepayment under the note.

G. LEGISLATION

If, after the date hereof, chactment or expiration of applicable laws have the effect either of rendering the provision of the Note, the Security Instrument or this Adjustable Rate Rider (other than this paragraph G) unenforceable according to their terms, or all or any part of the sums secured hereby uncollectable, as otherwise provided in the Security Instrument and this Adjustable Rate Rider, or of diminishing the value of the Lender's security, then Lender, at Lender's option, may declare all sums secured by the Security Instrument to be immediately due and payable. In such event, Borrower shall not have the right to relocate otherwise provided in the Non-Uniform Covenant 19 of the Security Instrument.

- H. TRANSFER OF PROPERTY: ASSUMPTION Covenant 17 of the Security Instrument is amended to read as follows:
 - 17. Transfer of Property: Assumption. If all or any part of the Property or an interest therein is sold or transferred by Borrower with Lender's prior written consent, excluding (a) the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this Security Instrument which does not relate to a transfer of rights of occupancy in the property, (b) the creation of a purchase money security interest for household appliances, (c) a transfer by devise, descent or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant or (d) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, Lender may, at Lender's option, declare all the sums secured by this Security Instrument to be immediately due and payable.

If Lender exercises such option to accelerate, Lender shall mail Borrower notice of acceleration in accordance with paragraph 14 hereto. Such notice shall provide a period of not less than 30 days from the date the notice is mailed within which Borrower may pay the sums declared due. If Borrower fails to pay such sums prior to the expiration of such period, Lender may, without further notice or demand on Borrower, invoke any remedies permitted by paragraph 18 hereof.

Lender will consent to a sale or transfer if: (1) Borrower causes to be submitted to Lender information required by Lender to evaluate the transferee as if a new loan were being made to the transferee; (2) Lender reasonably determines that Lender's security will not be impaired and that the risk of a breach of any covenant or agreement in this Security Instrument is acceptable; (3) Borrower makes payment of all or such lesser amount of unpaid accrued interest outstanding under the terms of the Note as Lender may require; (4) interest will be payable on the sums secured by this Security Instrument at a rate determined by adding 2.50% to the Index; (5) the transferee signs an assumption agreement that is acceptable to Lender and that obligates the transferee to keep all the promises and agreements made in the Note and in this Security Instrument. To the extent permitted by applicable law, Lender also may charge a reasonable fee as a condition to Lender's consent to any sale or transfer.

This loan will not be assumable if converted to a fixed interest rate,

Borrower will continue to be obligated under the Note and this Security Instrument unless Lender releases Borrower in writing.
