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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
PELHAM YOUTH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION, INC.,
AN ALABAMA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned individuals, being over the age of Nineteen (19) years, residents of the State of Alabama, and citizens of the United States, and desiring to form a non-profit corporation pursuant to the provisions of Section 10-3-1 et seq. of the Alabama Code of 1975, as amended, commonly referred to as the "Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act," do hereby adopt the following Articles of

Incorporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Pelham Youth Football Association, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) To provide competitive recreation for the youth of Pelham and the surrounding area, while aiding their development in physical education, team play and sportsman-like conduct.
- (b) To form an athletic organization that is non-denominational and which does not discriminate against any person because of race, sex, creed, color or national origin.
- (c) Charitable, benevolent, eleemosynary, educational, civic, social or any other lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Alabama Non-Profit Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The corporation shall have no members.

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FIFTH: Notwithstanding any of the powers or purposes of the corporation contained in these Articles of Incorporation or granted by law, this corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, nor shall it engage in any activity of any kind whatsoever involving the carrying on of propaganda, nor shall it attempt in any manner to influence legislation, nor shall it engage in any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, of the United States of America or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, of the United States of America.

SIXTH: In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the corporation will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c) (3) and 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation will not carry on other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Sections 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under

Section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

SEVENTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is 525 Creekview Drive, Pelham, Alabama, 35124, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Ronnie Bryan.

EIGHTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is nine (9) and the name, address and occupation of the persons who are to serve as the initial directors are:
