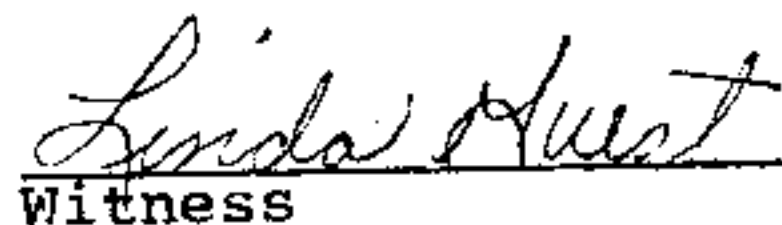
Testator's Acknowledgment

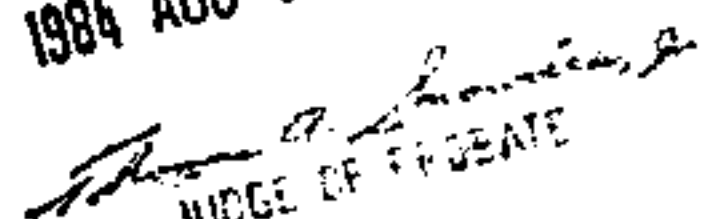
