## IN TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST:

In Section 12: Commence at the Southwest corner of the SW4 of NW4 and run North along the West boundary of said forty 420 feet; thence East parallel to the South line of said forty 105 feet to the point of beginning: thence continue East, parallel to the South line of said forty, 210 feet; thence South, parallel to the West line of said forty, 105 feet; thence West, parallel to the South line of said forty, 210 feet; thence North, parallel to the West line of said forty, 105 feet to the point of beginning.

It is agreed and understood between the Lessor and Lessee that wherever the fraction 1/8th appears in paragraph #3, it is amended to read 1/6th.

This lease does not cover coal, iron ore, or any other hard rock minerals.

Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, It is expressly agreed that this lease does not grant Lessee any right to enter upon the surface of the above described land.

This lease also covers and orchides, in addition to that above described, all land, if any, contiguous or adjacent to or adjoining the land above described and (a) owned or claimed by lessor by limitation, prescription, reversion or intrecorded instrument or (b) as to which lessor has a preference right of acquisition. Lessor agrees to execute any supplemental instrument requested by lesser for a more complete or accurate description of said land. For the purpose of determining the amount of any bonus or other payment hereunder, said land shall be deemed to contain

0.506 acres, whether actually containing more or less, and the above recital of acreage in any tract shall be deemed to be the true acreage thereof. Lessor accepts the homes as himp sum consideration for this lease and all rights, and options hereunder.

2. Unless somet terminated or longer kept in force under other provisions hereof, this lease shall remain in force for a term of packets from the date hereof, hereinafter called "primary term", and as

As rayalty, lessee covenants and agrees: (a) To deliver to the credit of lessor, in the pipe line to which lessee may connect its wells, the equal one-eighth part of all oil produced and saved by lessee from said land, or from time to time, at the option of lessee, to pay lessor, the average posted market price of such one-eighth part of such oil at the wells as of the day it is run to the pipe line or storage tanks, lessor's interest, in either case, to bear one-eighth of the cost of treating oil to render it marketable pipe line oil; (b) Tu pay lessor, one-eighth of the amount realisted by lessee, computed at the month of the well, or (2) when used by lessee off said land or in the manufacture of gasoline or other products, the market value, at the month of the well, of one-eighth of such gas and easinghead gas; (c) To pay lessor on all other minerals mined and marketed or utilized by lessee from said land, one-tenth either in kind or value at the well or nine at lessee's election, except that on sulphin mined and marketed the royalty shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per long ton. If, at the expiration of the primary term or at any times of times thereafter, there is any well on said land or on lands except that on sulphin mined and marketed the royalty shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per long ton. If, at the expiration of the primary term or at any time or times thereafter, there is any well on said land or on lands over the holds and or any portion thereof has been pooled, capable of prothecing gas or any other mineral covered hereby, and all such wells are shut-in, this lesse shall, nevertheless, continue in force as though operations were being conducted on said land for an long as said wells are shut-in, and thereafter this lesse may be continued in force as if no shut-in had occurred. Lessee convenants and agrees to use cashing the primary term, all such wells are shut-in for a period of ninety consecutive days, and during such time there are no operations on said land, then at or before the expiration of sai

If at any time that lessee pays or tenders shut in royalty, two or more parties are, or claim to be, entitled to receive same, lessee may, in lieu of any other method of payment berein provided, pay or tender such alust-in royalty, in the manner above specified, either jointly to such parties or separately to each in accordance with their respective ownerships thereof, as lessee may elect. Any payment bereinder may be made by check or draft of lessee deposited in the mail or delivered to the party entitled to receive payment or to a depository bank provided for alress on or before the last date for payment. Nothing herein shall impair lessee's right to release as provided in paragraph 5 hereof. In the event of assignment of this lesse in whole or in part, liability for payment between each other owners of this lesse, severally us to ocreage owned by each.

4 Lessee is hereby granted the right, at its option, to prof or unitize all or any part of said land and of this lesse as to any or all minerals or horizons thereunder, with other lands, lesse or leases, or portion or portions thereof, or mineral or lawizon thereunder, so as to establish units containing not more than 80 surface acres plus 10% acresge tolerance, provided, however, a unit may be established or an existing unit may be enlarged to contain not more than 640 acres plus 10% acresge tolerance, if unitized only as to gas and liquid hydrocarbons (condensate) which are not a liquid in the subsurface reservoir. If larger units are required, under any governmental rule or order, for the drilling or operation of a well at a regular location, or for obtaining maximum allowable, from any well to be drilled, drilling, or already drilled, any such unit may be established or enlarged, to conform to the size required by such governmental order or rule. Lessee shall exercise said option as to each desired unit by executing an outrument identifying such unit and filling it for record in the public office in which this lease is recorded. Each of said options may be exercised by lessee from time to time, and whether before or after production has been established either on taid land or on the portion of said land included in the unit or on other land unitized therewith and any such unit may include any well to be drilled, being drilled or already completed. A unit established hereunder shall be valid and effective for all purposes of this lease even though there may be land or mineral, royalty or leasehold interests in land within the unit which are not pooled or unitized. Any operations conducted on any part of such unitized hand shall be considered, for all purposes, except the payment of royalty, operations conducted under this lease. There shall be allocated to the land covered by this lease included in any such unit that proportion of the total production of unitized minerals from wells in the unit, after deducting any used to lease or unit operations, which the number of surface acres in the land covered by this least included in the unit hears to the total number of surface acres in the unit. The production so allocated shall be considered for all purposes, including the payment or delivery of covalty: overriding royalty, and any other psyments out of production, to the entire production of unitized minerals from the portion of said land covered hereby and included in such until in the same manner as though produced from said land moder the terms of this lease. The owner of the revisionary estate of any term royalty or mineral estate agrees that the accrual of royalties pursuant to the paragraph or of shot-in royalties from a well on the unit shall satisfy any limitation of term requiring production of oil or gas. The formation of such unit shall not have the effect of changing the ownership of any shut-in production cavalty which mus become payable under this lease. Neither shall it impair the right of lessee to release from this lease all or any portion of said land, except that lessee may not so release as to lands within a unit while there are operations thereon for unitized minerals unless all pushed leases are released as to lands within the unit. Lessee may dissolve any unit established becounder by filing for record in the public office where this lease is recorded a declaration to that effect, if at that time no operations are being conducted thereon for unitized minerals. Subject to the provisions of this paragraph 4, a unit once established becoming shall remain to force so long as any lease subject thereto shall remain in force. A unit may be so established, modified or dissolved during the life of this lease

5 Leave may at any time and from time to time execute and deliver to lessor or file for record a release or releases of this lease as to any part or all of said land or of any mineral or havinon thereunder, and thereby, relieved of all obligations as to the released acreage or interest.

6 This is a PAID-UP LEASE. In consideration of the down cash payment, Lessor agrees that Lessee shall not be obligated except as otherwise provided herein, to commence or continue any operations during the primary term. Whenever used in this lesse the word "operations" shall mean operations for and any of the following, drilling, testing, completing, reworking, recompleting, deepening, plugging back or reporting of a well in search for or in an embrasor to obtain production of oil, gas, sulphur or other mineral, whether or not in paying quantities

7 Leaves shall have the use, free from toyalty, of water, other than from lessor's water wells, and of oil and gas produced from said land in all operations beresider. All of the covenants, obligations, and considerations of this lease shall extend to and be binding upon the parties hereto, their beies, successors, essigns, and successive assigns. No change or division in the ownership of said land, royalties, or other memorys, or any part thereof, however effected, shall in reuse the obligations or duminish the rights of lessee, including, but not limited to, the location and drilling of wells and the measurement of production. The service of said notice shall he precedent to the bringing of any action by lessor on said lesse for any cause, and no such action shall be brought until the lapse of sixty (60) days after service of such notice on lesser. Neither the service of said native nor the doing of any acts by lesser nimed to meet all or any of the alleged breaches shall be deemed an admission or presumption that lesser has failed to perform all its obligations beresider. Lessee shall also have such casements on said land as are necessary to operation on the acresse so retained. 10 Lessor bereby warrants and agrees to defend title to said land against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
