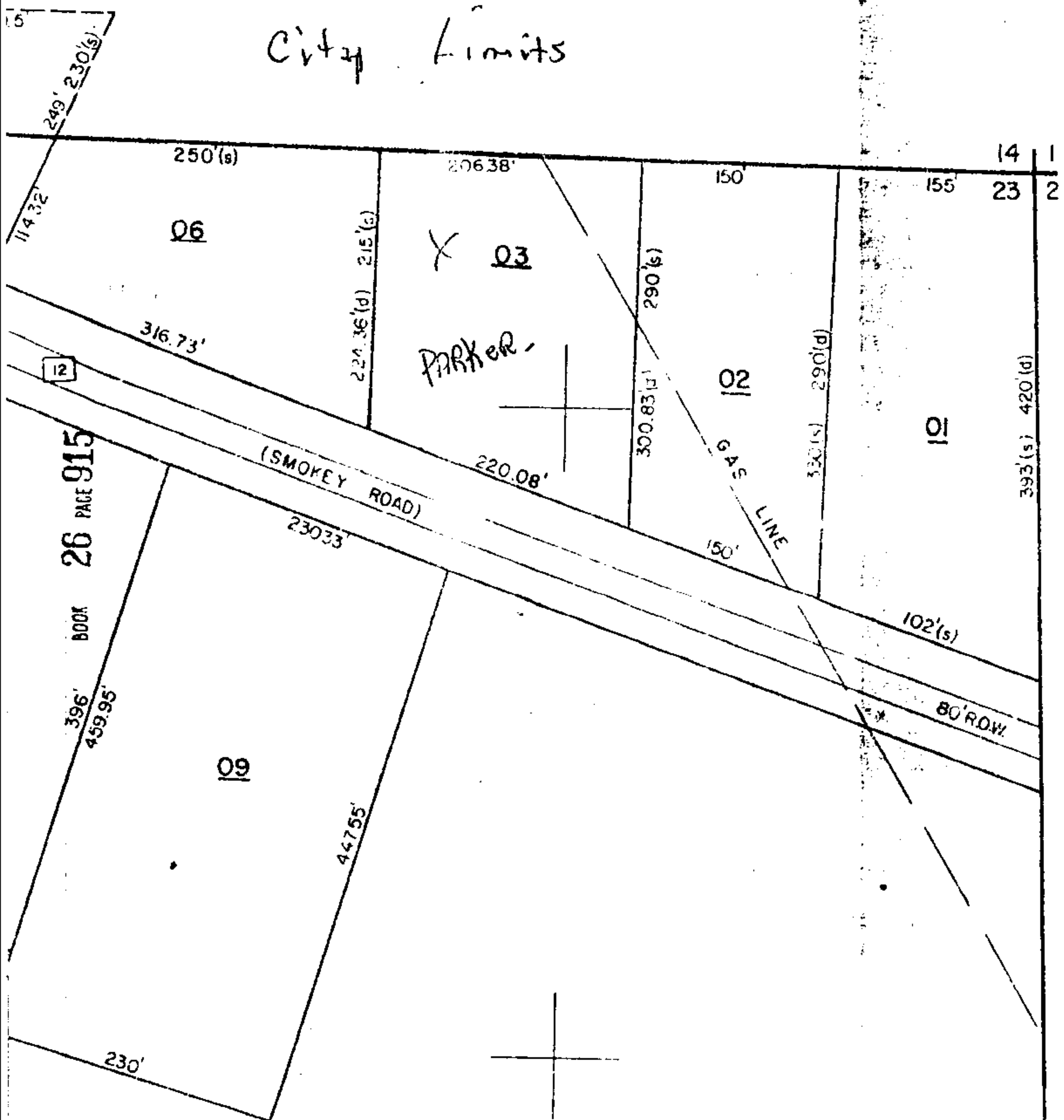

ORDINANCE #174

WHEREAS on the 1st day of November, 1984,
CHARLES EDWIN PARKER, JR., and wife, KAY BUTLER PARKER, filed a
petition with the City Clerk of the City of Alabaster as required
by Sections 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975,
petitioning and requesting that the property hereinafter described
be annexed to the municipality of the City of Alabaster, Alabama
and requesting the Mayor and Council of said city to adopt an
ordinance assenting to the annexation of said property to such
municipality, which petition contained an accurate description of
the property or territory proposed to be annexed together with a
map of the said territory showing its relationship to the corporate
limits of the City of Alabaster, and the signatures of the owners
of the property or territory described were signed thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF ALABASTER, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

That the City of Alabaster does adopt this ordinance
assenting to the annexation of the following described property or
territory to the municipality of the City of Alabaster. Said
property being described as follows:

Commence at the Northeast corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$
of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, Shelby
County, Alabama; thence Westerly along the North line
of said Section 23, 304.68 feet to the point of

beginning; thence continue along last described course 206.38 feet to a point; thence 90 deg. left 224.36 feet to a point on the North right-of-way line of Highway No. 12; thence 69 deg. 40 min. left 220.08 feet along the said North right-of-way line of Highway No. 12 to a point; thence 110 deg. 20 min. left 300.83 feet to the point of beginning. Containing 1.24 acres. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Be it further ordained that the corporate limits of the City of Alabaster be extended and rearranged so as to embrace and include such property and such property or territory shall become a part of the corporate area of such municipality upon the date of publication of this Ordinance, as provided for in Sections 11-42-20 and 11-42-21, Code of Alabama 1975.

Be it further ordained that the City Clerk be and she is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance, along with an accurate description of the property or territory being annexed, together with a map of the said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City of Alabaster to which said territory is being annexed in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Be it further Ordained that the Zoning Map of the City of Alabaster, and any other official maps or surveys of the City, shall be amended to reflect the annexation of the above-described property, and that Section 2-2(b) of the Code of Ordinances, City of Alabaster, Alabama, be amended to reflect that this property is located in Ward 5.

Whereupon, the Mayor in open council declared said motion carried and unanimous consent given for the immediate consideration of and action upon said Ordinance.

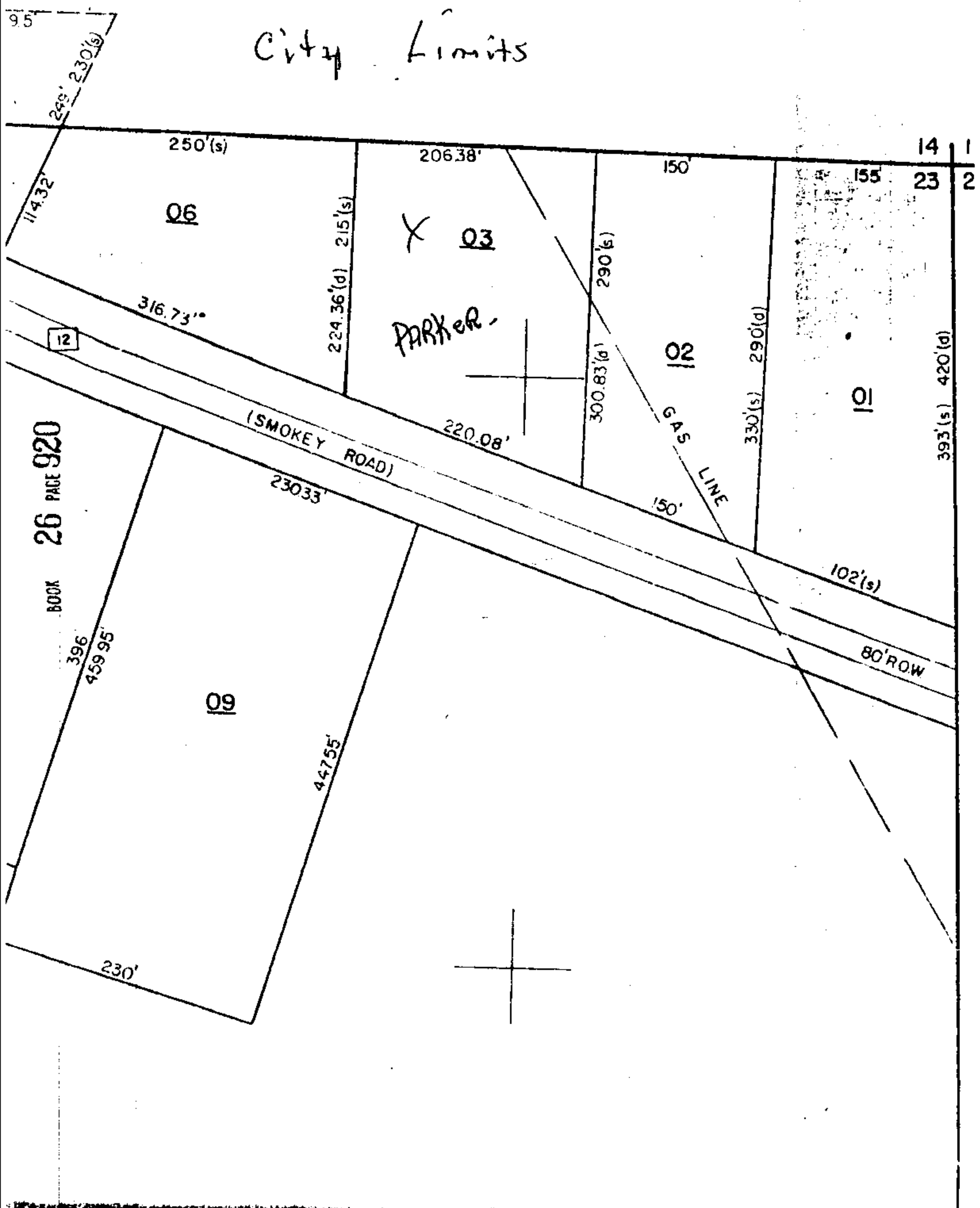

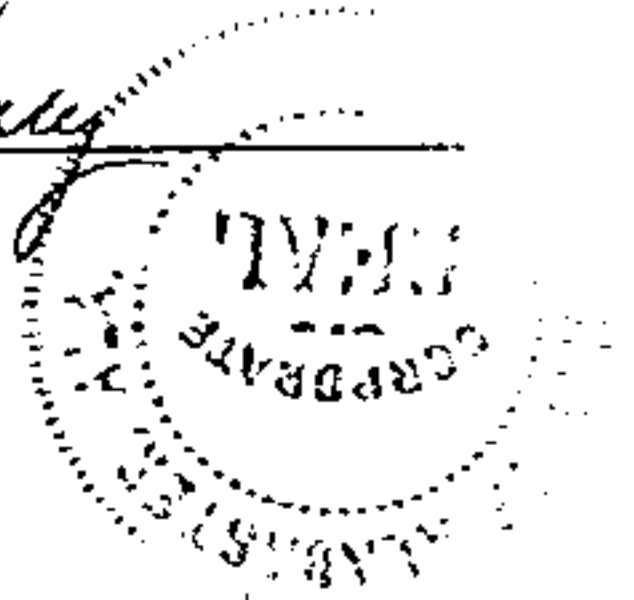
