NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the provisions of the said Treaty, **HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED**, and by these presents **DOES GIVE AND GRANT**, unto the said *Choys or Choys on*

and to her heirs, the said tract of land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the ^{said tract of land} ~~same~~ together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said ~~Thos. & Chas. Tom~~ and to her heirs and assigns for ever.
