

ARTICLES OF OF MERGER

The undersigned corporations pursuant to Section 85, Act No. 80-633 known as the Alabama Business Corporation Act, hereby execute the following articles of merger:

ARTICLE ONE

The plan of merger is as follows:

PLAN OF MERGER

BROWNING-FERRIS INDUSTRIES OF ALABAMA, INC., an Alabama corporation, (the "Surviving Corporation"), hereby merges with and into itself, HOOVER SANITATION SERVICE, INC., an Alabama corporation, (the "Merged Corporation"). BROWNING-FERRIS INDUSTRIES OF ALABAMA, INC. shall be the Surviving Corporation. The Articles of Incorporation and By-laws of BROWNING-FERRIS INDUSTRIES OF ALABAMA, INC. shall be the Articles of Incorporation and By-laws of the Surviving Corporation.

On the effective date of the merger, each share of the issued and outstanding stock of the Merged Corporation shall forthwith be cancelled and no shares of the Surviving Corporation will be issued in exchange therefore. All of the property, rights, privileges, leases and patents of the Merged Corporation are to be transferred to and become the property of the Surviving Corporation.

Browning-Ferris Industries, Inc., a Delaware corporation, is the Sole Shareholder of both Browning-Ferris Industries of Alabama, Inc. and Hoover Sanitation Service, Inc., and it approved of said merger by taking the following action by unanimous written consent on December 18, 1984.

RESOLVED, that Hoover Sanitation Service, Inc. shall be merged into Browning-Ferris Industries of Alabama, Inc. pursuant to the Plan of Merger set forth in the attached Articles of Merger.
