

APPEAL BOND TO COURT OF APPEALS—CRIMINAL CASES

The State of Alabama, }
Coosa County. } IN THE CIRCUIT COURT.

We Walter Maddox and
Sureties agree to pay to the State of Alabama
the sum of Ten Thousand and 00/100 Dollars, unless the said
Walter Maddox appears at the next
term of the Circuit Court of Coosa County, and from term to term thereafter un-
til discharged by law, to answer a criminal prosecution for the offense of Bribery of
a Public Servant, Guilty by Jury Trial, Sentenced to
five (5) years and no days.

And we, and each of us, hereby waive all exemptions we may have to any personal property
under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama as to the collection of the penalty of this
bond.

Walter Maddox was duly convicted in the Circuit Court of
Coosa County on the 4 day of Dec., 19 84, of

the above stated offense, and has duly applied for and obtained an appeal from said conviction and
sentence to the Court of Appeals for the State of Alabama, and the amount of his appeal bond has
been duly and legally fixed at said above stated sum:

Now, therefore, if the said Walter Maddox

shall appear at the next term of the Circuit Court of Coosa County, and
from term to term thereafter until discharged by law, and abide the judgment of the said Court of
Appeals for the State of Alabama, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to re-
main in full force and effect.
