This cause coming on to be heard on the Motion Docket on March 12, 1985, and the parties or their attorneys being present in Court, announced that the parties have entered into a consent settlement of this cause, and after due consideration thereof, the Court is of the opinion that the settlement should be and the same is hereby approved, and:

IT IS THEREFORE, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED, by the Court as follows:

1. That the Defendant will construct a twenty-four (24) inch open-type PVC drain pipe in the immediate vicinity of the drain as shown on the attached Exhibit "A" within sixty (60) days hereof at Defendant's expense. That the Defendant will further keep both ends of said drain pipe free of debris.
2. The Defendant will keep clean and clear of debris all ditches on his property.
3. Court costs should be and the same are hereby taxed equally against the Plaintiff and the Defendant for which execution shall issue after the expiration of thirty (30) days.
