LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land located in the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4, and NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, and the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4, all in Section 14, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows: Commence at the Southwest corner of the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 14; thence in a Northerly direction, along the West line of said quarter-quarter Section, a distance of 536.56 feet to a point on the Northwest right of way line of Parker Drive (extended); thence 41 deg. 28 min. 50 sec. right, in a Northeasterly direction along said right of way line, a distance of 870.82 feet, to a point on the Southwest right of way line of Seaboard Coast Line Railroad; thence 90 deg. left, in a Northwesterly direction along said right of way line, a distance of 106.0 feet to the beginning of a curve to the left, said curve having a radius of 2774.63 feet and a central angle of 4 deg. 12 min.; thence along arc of said curve, in a Northwesterly direction, along said right of way line, a distance of 203.39 feet to end of said curve; thence continue in a Northwesterly direction, along said right of way line, a distance of 381.84 feet; thence 85 deg. 48 min. left, in a Southwesterly direction, a distance of 40.0 feet to the point of beginning; thence continue along last described course, a distance of 584.42 feet; thence 90 deg. right, in a Northwesterly direction a distance of 250.0 feet; thence 90 deg. right, in a Northeasterly direction, a distance of 593.0 feet, more or less, to a point on the Southerly right of way line of said Seaboard Coast Line Railroad; thence in a Southeasterly direction, along said right of way line, a distance of 100 feet, more or less; thence in a Southeasterly direction, a distance of 155 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
