O. Box 3199, Tuscaloosa, AL 35401, as Lessors, and Atlantic Richfield Company, as Lessee, recorded in Book 324, Page 385 of the records of Shelby County, State of Alabama, INSOFAR AND INSOFAR ONLY as said Lease covers the following described land:

By change of name effective May 3, 1966, The Atlantic Refining Company became Atlantic Richfield Company. Effective as of March 4, 1969, Sinclair Oil Corporation, a New York corporation, was merged into Atlantic Richfield Company. By merger on May 7, 1985, Atlantic Richfield Company, a Pennsylvania Corporation was succeeded by Atlantic Richfield Company, a Delaware Corporation.
