} KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Whereas,

(hereinafter called "Mortgagors", whether one or more) are justly indebted, to Shelby State Bank, an Alabama Banking Corporation

(hereinafter called "Mortgagors", whether one or more), in the sum of -----Two Hundred Thousand and no/100----- DOLLARS (\$200,000.00), evidenced by their note of even date

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And Whereas, Mortgagors agreed, in incurring said indebtedness, that this mortgage should be given to secure the prompt payment thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, said Mortgagors, James E. Bishop and wife, Ramona S. Bishop

and all others executing this mortgage, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the Mortgagors the following described real estate, situated in Shelby County, State of Alabama, to-wit:

Commence at the Northeast corner of the S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabama; thence run South along the East 1/4 1/4 line a distance of 120.24 feet to the intersection of said line with the easterly right of way of U. S. Highway #31 and the point of beginning; thence continue last course a distance of 310.0 feet; thence turn right 90 deg. 21 min. a distance of 157.25 feet to a point on the easterly right of way of U. S. Highway 31; thence turn right 116 deg. 37 min. and run northeasterly along said right of way a distance of 346.74 feet to the point of beginning; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Said property is warranted free from all incumbrances and against any adverse claims, except as stated above.

To Have And To Hold the above granted property unto the said Mortgagor, Mortgagor's successors, heirs, and assigns forever; and for the purpose of further securing the payment of said indebtedness, the undersigned agrees to pay all taxes or assessments when imposed legally upon said premises, and should default be made in the payment of same, the said Mortgagor may at Mortgagee's option pay off the same; and to further secure said indebtedness, first above named undersigned agrees to keep the improvements on said real estate insured against loss or damage by fire, lightning and tornado for the fair and reasonable insurable value thereof, in companies satisfactory to the Mortgagee, with loss, if any, payable to said Mortgagee; as Mortgagee's interest may appear, and to promptly deliver said policies, or any renewal of said policies to said Mortgagee; and if undersigned fail to keep said property insured as above specified, or fail to deliver said insurance policies to said Mortgagee, then the said Mortgagee, or assigns, may at Mortgagee's option insure said property for said sum, for Mortgagee's own benefit, the policy if collected, to be credited on said indebtedness, less cost of collecting same; all amounts so expended by said Mortgagor for taxes, assessments or insurance, shall become a debt to said Mortgagor or assigns, additional to the debt hereby specially secured, and shall be covered by this Mortgage, and bear interest from date of payment by said Mortgagee, or assigns, and be at once due and payable.

Upon condition, however, that if the said Mortgagor pays said indebtedness, and reimburses said Mortgagor or assigns for any amounts Mortgagor may have expended for taxes, assessments, and insurance, and interest thereon, then this conveyance to be null and void; but should default be made in the payment of any sum expended by the said Mortgagor or assigns, or should said indebtedness hereby secured, or any part thereof, or the interest thereon, remain unpaid at maturity, or should the interest of said Mortgagor or assigns in said property become endangered by reason of the enforcement of any prior lien or incumbrance thereon, so as to endanger the debt hereby secured, then in any one of said events, the whole of said indebtedness hereby secured shall at once become due and payable, and this mortgage be subject to foreclosure as now provided by law in case of past due mortgages, and the said Mortgagor, agents or assigns, shall be authorized to take possession of the premises hereby conveyed, and with or without first taking possession, after giving twenty-one days' notice, by publication in some newspaper published once a week for three consecutive weeks, the time, place and terms of sale, by publication in some newspaper published in said County and State, sell the same in lots or parcels or en masse as Mortgagee, agents or assigns deem best, in front of the Court House door of said County, (or the division thereof) where said property is located, at public outcry, to the highest bidder for cash, and apply the proceeds of the sale: First, to the expense of advertising, selling and conveying, including a reasonable attorney's fee; Second, to the payment of any amounts that may have been expended, or that it may then be necessary to expend, in paying insurance, taxes, or other incumbrances, with interest thereon; Third, to the payment of said indebtedness in full, whether the same shall or shall not have fully matured at the date of said sale, but no interest shall be collected beyond the day of sale; and Fourth, the balance, if any, to be turned over to the said Mortgagor and undersigned further agree that said Mortgagor, agents or assigns may bid at said sale and purchase said property, if the highest bidder therefor; and undersigned further agree to pay a reasonable attorney's fee to said Mortgagor or assigns, for the foreclosure of this mortgage in Chancery, should the same be so foreclosed, said fee to be a part of the debt hereby secured.
