Whereas David Greenwood, of Shelby County, Mississippi, deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said David Greenwood, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the West half of the North West quarter of Section twelve, in Township twenty, of Range two, East, in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing eighty acres and forty hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said David Greenwood;
