

ALABAMA POWER COMPANY
AGREEMENT FOR UPGRADING UNDERGROUND WIRING FACILITIES
FOR
MOBILE HOME PARKS

The Agreement made this 7 day of March, 1986, by and between Alabama Power Company (the "Company") and Robert M. Byrd, Jr. (the "Owner") with respect to provision of electric service to Bolee Mobile Home Park (the "mobile home park") located on a parcel of land in Shelby County, Alabama, as more particularly described in that certain deed dated July 31 1972, from Corchem, Inc., a Delaware Corp. to Robert M. Byrd, Jr., as recorded in Deed Book 276, page 118, in the Office of the Judge of Probate of said county.

WHEREAS, the Company and Owner have heretofore entered into an Electric Service Entrance Agreement Dated 8-4-1972, 4-18-1973, 7-25-1974 pursuant to which the Company installed underground service facilities and pedestal-mounted combination meter socket and mobile home power panels for each mobile home space in the mobile home park, with the Company retaining title to all of such facilities; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the installation by the Company of the new facilities, the Company and the Owner agree that:

2. With respect to each lot in the mobile home park for which a new mobile home power panel is installed hereunder, neither the Company or the Owner shall have any further rights or obligations under the Electric Service Entrance Agreement dated 8-4-1972, 4-18-1973, 7-25-1974 between the Company and the Owner.
