

AN ORDINANCE TO ALTER, REARRANGE AND EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, SO AS TO EMBRACE AND INCLUDE WITHIN THE CORPORATE AREA OF SAID CITY ALL TERRITORY NOW WITHIN SUCH CORPORATE LIMITS AND ALSO CERTAIN OTHER TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, certain petitions signed by the owners of all of the land within the territory therein described and proposed to be annexed to the City, together with a map of said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Birmingham; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined and found that the matters set forth and alleged in said petition are true, and that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the City of Birmingham;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Birmingham as follows:

Section 1. That said Council hereby assents to the annexation of said territory to the City of Birmingham, Alabama, the corporate limits of the City to be extended and rearranged pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 42, Article 2, Code of Alabama 1975 (Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-23, as amended) so as to embrace and include said territory, in addition to the territory already within its present corporate limits, within the corporate area of said City, which said territory is not within the corporate limits or police jurisdiction of another municipality and the new boundary line does not lie at any point more than half the distance between the old city boundary and the corporate boundary of any municipality. Said territory is described as follows:

Pursuant to the provisions of Act No. 787 of the 1977 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama, and the full extent of the authority of the City of Birmingham thereunder, for a period of fifteen years from the date hereof said property and all property and businesses situated thereon shall be exempt from all ad valorem taxes levied by the City of Birmingham, from all occupational license taxes based on wages or salaries of persons working thereon, from all business license taxes in excess of those provided by the provisions of Section 11-42-83(a), Code of Alabama 1975, and from all sales taxes levied by this said City except with respect to retail sales made by businesses in the annexation area.

Section 3. The City of Birmingham hereby agrees to comply with those provisions of Act No. 604 enacted at the 1976 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama pertaining to the assumption and payment of an annexed fire district's debt or the payment to said fire district of an amount equal to six times the amount of dues that the portion of said fire district being annexed paid to said fire district during the preceding year.

Section 4. That the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance containing an accurate description of said annexed territory with the Probate Judge of Jefferson County, Alabama, and also cause a copy of this ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Birmingham.

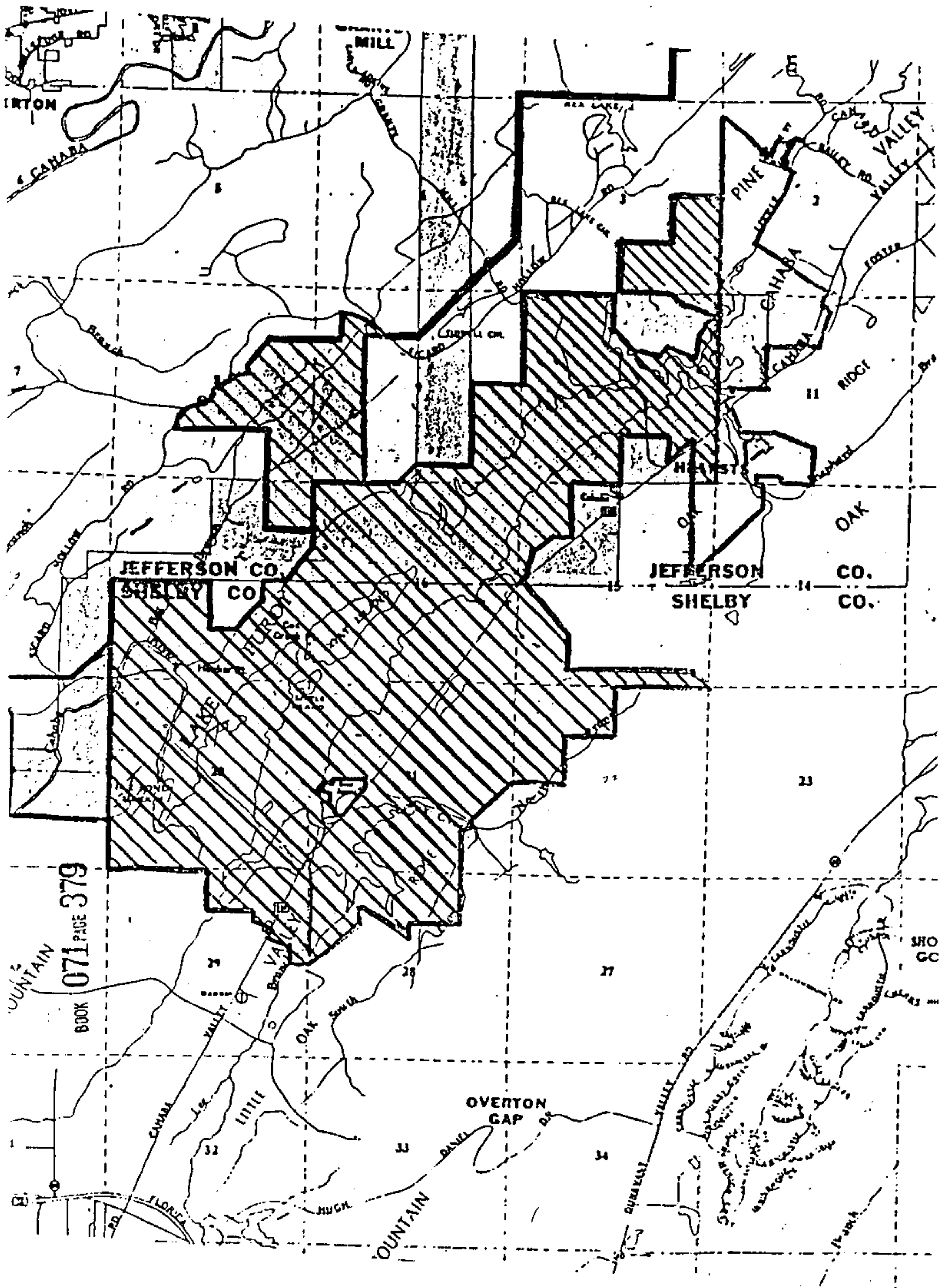

Begin at the Southeast corner of said forty and proceed Westerly along the South boundary line of said forty 1061.08 feet to a stake on the East boundary of the Caldwell Mill Road; thence turn an angle to the right 88°29' and proceed in a Northerly direction along the East boundary of said road 299.37 feet; thence turn an angle to the right 11°44' and proceed in the East boundary of said road 292.71 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 11°14' and proceed in a Northerly direction in the East boundary of said road 97.16 feet to an iron stake; thence turn an angle to the right of 68°37' and proceed in an Easterly direction 965.44 feet to an iron stake in the East boundary of said forty; thence turn an angle to the right of 88°42' and proceed in a Southerly direction along the East line of said forty 677.32 feet to point of beginning.

Section 2. The City of Birmingham hereby agrees to comply with those provisions of Act No. 604 enacted at the 1976 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama pertaining to the assumption and payment of an annexed fire district's debt or the payment to said fire district of an amount equal to six times the amount of dues that the portion of said fire district being annexed paid to said fire district during the preceding year, to the extent authorized by this annexation.

Section 3. That the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance containing an accurate description of said annexed territory with the Probate Judge of Jefferson County, Alabama, and also cause a copy of this ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Birmingham.

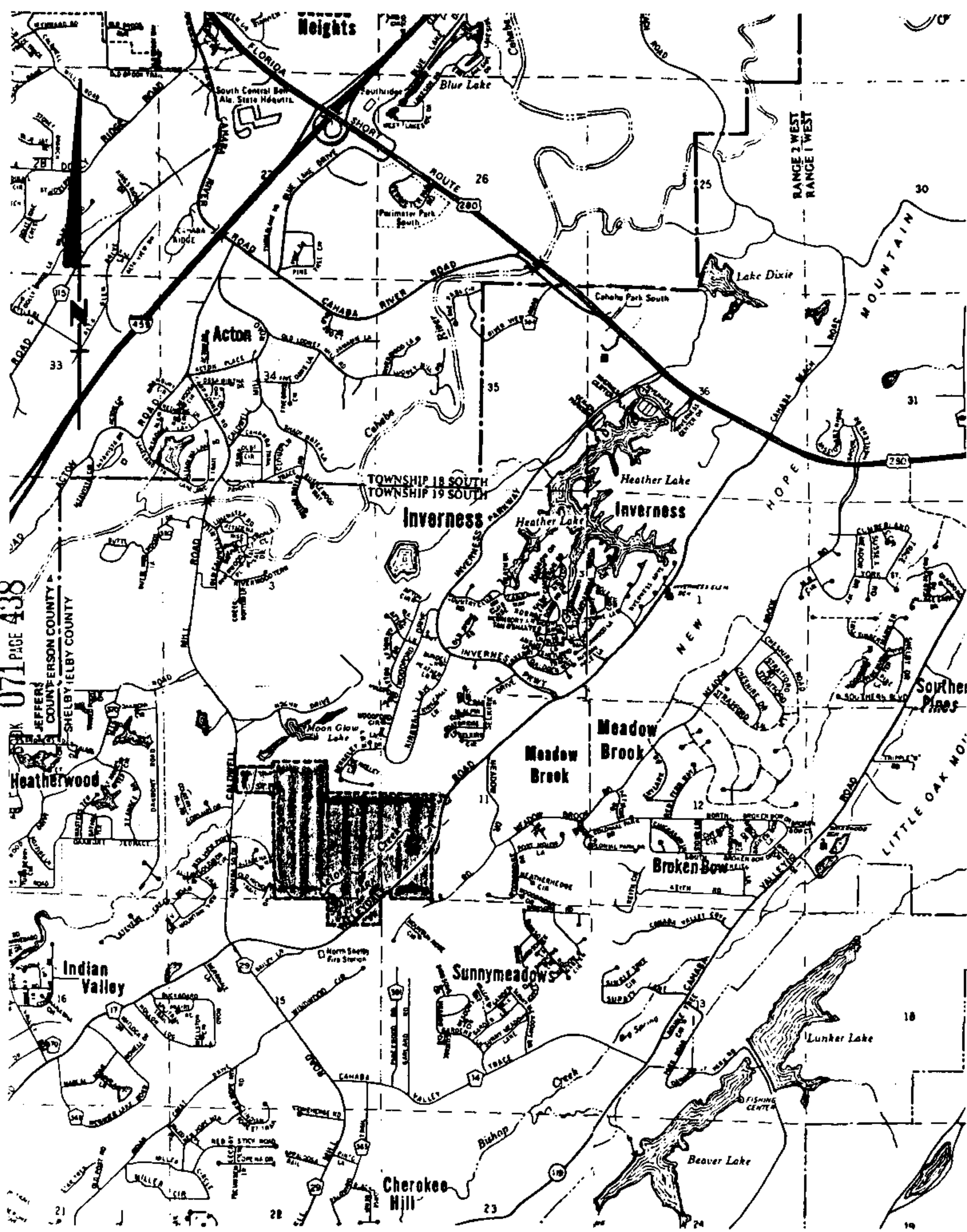

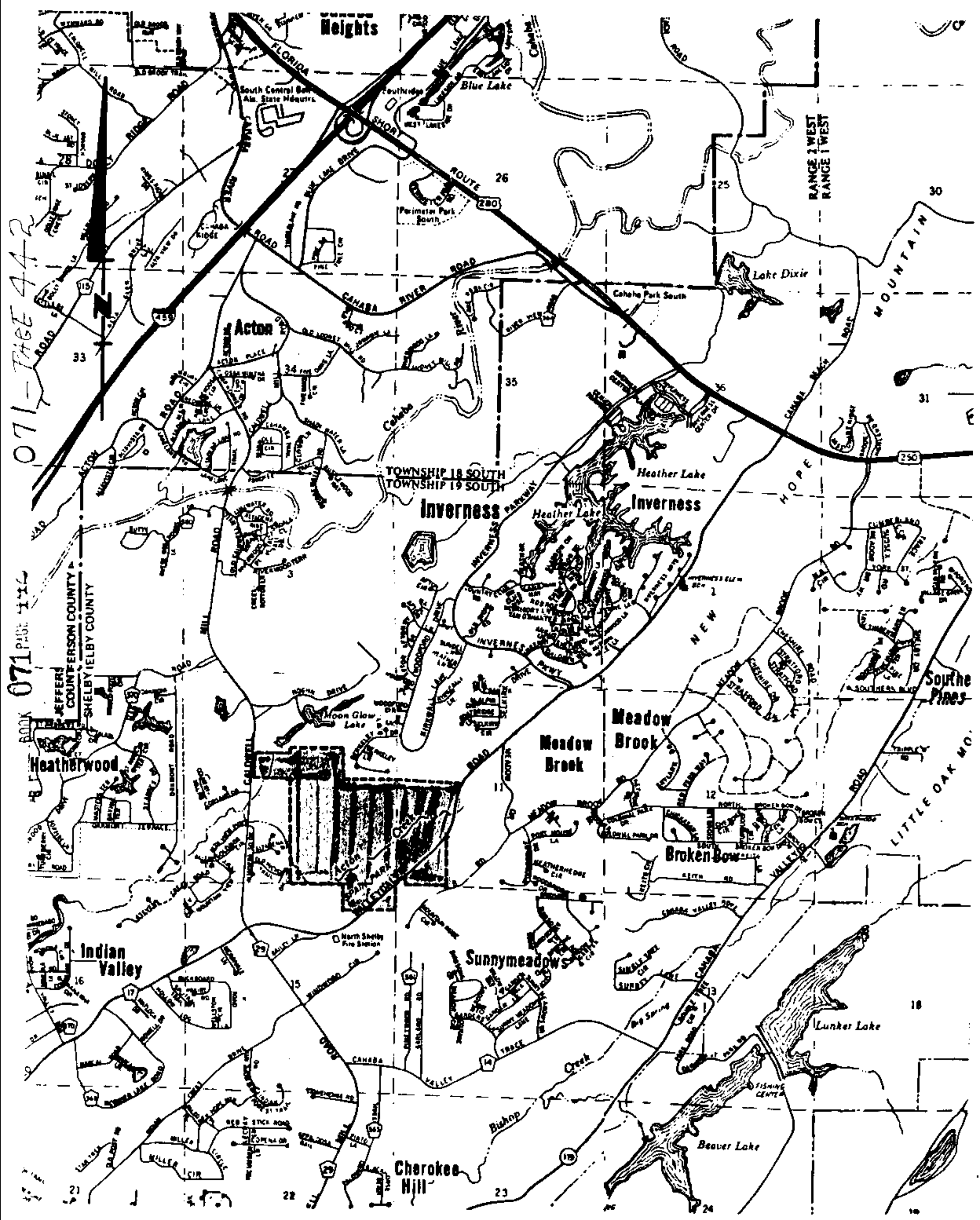
