ORDINANCE NO. 86 - 101

AN ORDINANCE TO ALTER, REARRANGE AND EXTEND THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA, SO AS TO EMBRACE AND INCLUDE WITHIN THE CORPORATE AREA OF SAID CITY ALL TERRITORY NOW WITHIN SUCII CORPORATE LIMITS AND ALSO CERTAIN OTHER TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO SAID CITY.

WHEREAS, a certain petition signed by Water Works Board of the City of Birmingham territory therein described be annexed to the City, together with a map of said territory showing its relationship to the corporate limits of the City has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Birmingham; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined and found that the matters set forth and alleged in said petition are true, and that it is in the public interest that said property be annexed to the City of Birmingham;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Birmingham as follows:

Section 1. That said Council hereby assents to the annexation of said territory to the City of Birmingham, Aiabama, the corporate limits of the City to be extended and rearranged pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 42, Article 2, Code of Alabama 1975 (Sections 11-42-20 through 11-42-23, as amended) so as to embrace and include said territory, in addition to the territory already within its present corporate limits, within the corporate area of said City, which said territory is not within the corporate limits or "City boundary" of another municipality and the new boundary line does not lie at any point more than half the distance between the old city boundary and the corporate boundary of any municipality. Said territory is described as follows:

Eity of Bham

Begin at the intersection of the right-of-way of Shelby County Road 119 (Cahaba Valley Road) and the corporate limits of the City of Birmingham in Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 1 West; run Southwesterly along said right-of-way of said Shelby County Road 119, the full width thereof, to its intersection with the Southerly limits of the right-of-way of U.S. Highway 280 in Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 1 West; thence run Westerly along the right-of-way of said U.S. Highway 280 to its intersection with the Westerly line of the right-of-way of Meadowbrook Drive in Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 1 West; thence run Southerly and Westerly along the right-of-way of said Meadowbrook Drive to the Westerly line of the right-of-way of Woodbridge Drive extended in Section 11, Township 19 South, Range 2 West; thence including the following described tract contiguous to said right-of-way of Meadowbrook Drive:

Part of the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, Section 11, Township 19 South, Range 2 West, Shelby County, Alabama, said part being more particularly described as follows: From the Southwest corner of said NW 1/4 of SE 1/4, run North along the West line of said 1/4-1/4 section for a distance of 609.13 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 114° 59' and run Southeasterly for a distance of 290.41 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 90° and run Northeasterly for a distance of 212.62 feet to the point of beginning of the property herein described; thence continue Northeasterly along the same course for a distance of 24.88 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 126° 30' and run Southeasterly for a distance of 210.39 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 90° and run Northeasterly for a distance of 140 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 900 and run Southeasterly for a distance of 280 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 90° and run Southwesterly for a distance of 160 feet; thence turn an angle to the right of 90° and run Northwesterly for a distance of 475.59 feet to the point of beginning.


Section 2. The City of Birmingham hereby agrees to comply with those provisions of Act No. 604 enacted at the 1976 Regular Session of the Legislature of Alabama pertaining to the assumption and payment of an annexed fire district's debt or the payment to said fire district of an amount equal to six times the amount of dues that the portion of said fire district being annexed paid to said fire district during the preceding year.

Section 3. That the City Clerk shall file a certified copy of this ordinance containing an accurate description of said annexed territory with the Probate Judge of Jefferson County, Alabama, and also cause a copy of this ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Birmingham.
