It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that said instrument be duly admitted to probate as the last will and testament of said Alice Marguerite Boner, deceased, and ordered to be recorded together with the proof thereof and all other papers on file relating to this proceeding. It is further ordered that petitioner, pay the costs of this proceeding.

Should either of my parents predecease the other, then it is my will and desire that my surviving parent shall be my Executor or Executrix as set out above.
