- Plaintiff agrees to withhold execution as long as D. the terms of this consent judgment are met and honored. In the event Defendants fail to make said monthly installments, Plaintiff may begin lawful execution or garnishments against said Defendants. Plaintiff is granted the right to record this judgment.
