2. Said death has been known for more than five days; and said decedent left no last will and testament.

ORDER GRANTING LETTERS OF ADMINISTRATION

That the death of the intestate has been known more than five days; and that petitioner is the widow of said deceased; and praying that Letters of Administration may be granted to her upon her entering into bond in such sum and with such securities as are required by law; and said petitioner having filed bond as such Administrator rix in the sum of Thirty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred and No/100-(\$38,500.00) Dollars, with St. Paul Fire and Marine Insurance Company as security thereon, payable and conditioned as the law directs, and approved by the Judge of this Court.
