ORDER

The parties, both with attorneys, came on for a hearing on Mrs. Thornton's rule nisi petition. An agreement was presented to the court, and, it is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:

(1) James Frederick Thornton shall sign all documents he was ordered to sign or which are necessary to reflect the awards of the divorce decree, within thirty (30) days. If he does not, then the court shall empower the Clerk of the court to execute such.

(2) Judgment is hereby entered in favor of Charlotte Thornton and against James Frederick Thornton in the amount of Twelve Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$12,350.00), which amount includes judgment to Mrs. Thornton for the loan she has paid which, according to the divorce decree, was the duty of Mr. Thornton to pay, and also the attorney's fee for the services of Eason Mitchell in this case.

Costs of court will not be taxed at this time, since this case remains open to determine whether or not Mr. Thornton complies with order (1) above.
