Bent with our seals and dated, this day of October, 1917.

The condition of this obligation be such, That whenever, in the opinion of the Probate Judge,  
it shall appear that Albert C. Morris, Franklin R. Younger, and Andrew G. Patterson,

have been appointed Administrators of the Estate of Charles L. Ruggard, deceased,

then, therefore, if the said Administrators shall duly discharge their duties, as such  
Administrators, shall then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full

force and effect.

And we, and each of us hereby waive all rights of claim of compensation for payment proper, as, or either of us have  
now or may hereafter have, under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, and we hereby severally certify that we have  
property free from all encumbrances to the full amount of Eighty thousand.
